There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

**Notice for applicants with
warrants or unpaid fines:**

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

This report is written by Police Officer Penny Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 01/23/24 at 11:19p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Subject with Gun at 2901 N. Dr. William Finlayson. The agent was on scene and advised officers a fight took place inside the establishment and a subject pulled out a gun. The agent stated they search males; therefore, they think a female snuck the gun in her purse. The business was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident.
 2. On 02/13/24 at 9:55p.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check at 2901 N. Dr. William Finlayson. Officers observed parking issues related to the business and asked an employee to make an announcement to have patrons legally park their cars. Officers further advised the agent the license's that were posted were not current. The agent later walked into the District to show the current licenses.

3. On 08/04/24 at 4:20p.m., Milwaukee Police took a walk-in Battery that occurred at approximately 12:50a.m., in front of 2901 N. Dr. William Finlayson. Officers were advised the victim had just left the club, when two suspects who were in the club earlier, battered her. The victim stated they didn't call the police at the time of the incident, since the suspects fled immediately after.

4. On 10/29/24 at 9:32p.m., Milwaukee Police took a walk-in Domestic Violence complaint that occurred at 2901 N. Dr. William Finlayson. Officers were advised the victim was at the club, when the suspect entered the business and caused a disturbance, knocking the victim's food to the ground. The suspect also made a threat, when the victim comes outside, they would shoot them. Security was advised and told the victim to go to the District and file a complaint.

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5. On 06/11/25 at 12:16a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a battery at 2901 N Dr William Finlayson Dr. The caller stated a security guard held them while another subject hitting them in the face. The business denied any physical fight took place, however, after viewing video surveillance, officers did observe a subject wearing a badge around their neck, holding the victim, while another subject punched the victim in the face. The Agent was on scene and stated they did not recognize either of the subjects attacking the victim.

This report is written by P.O. Jonathan ENDERLE, assigned to District 5, Late Shift.

DISPATCH & INITIAL OBSERVATIONS

On Wednesday, June 11th, 2025, at 12:16 A.M., while assigned to Squad 5330 with P.O. Tashumi WILLIAMS, operating a marked police vehicle, in full duty uniform, with body-worn camera worn and activated, I was dispatched to the intersection of N. Dr. William Finlayson Dr. and W. Locust St. for a Battery - In Progress call. The caller stated that she had been assaulted by a security guard at Savoy's Night Club at 2901 N. Dr. William Finlayson St., and was waiting in a 2025 Nissan Rogue with the hazard lights on parked on N. Dr. William Finlayson Dr. Upon arrival I observed a Nissan Rogue parked facing northbound on N. Dr. William Finlayson Dr., where I made contact with a F/B subject, later identified as the caller/victim, Antoinette B. BATES (F/B 04/24/1989).

INTERVIEW OF CALLER (BATES)

BATES stated the incident started when she and an employee at Savoy's, whom she knew, later spoken to and identified as ALEXZANDER K. LOVE (M/B 11/02/1992), had been repeatedly entering and exiting through a back door to the patio. BATES stated that the owner of the property, later spoken to and identified as Tina M. JOHNSON-WILLIAMS (F/B 06/01/1967), after hearing the door slam, had shouted "Who's gonna pay for that fucking door". BATES then said that LOVE would be responsible for it.

BATES stated that then a woman, who she believed to be JOHNSON-WILLIAMS' niece, shouted at BATES, saying "nobody disrespects my titi". BATES responded that she was not disrespecting JOHNSON-WILLIAMS, as BATES knew JOHNSON-WILLIAMS and was friendly with her. BATES stated that the woman then shouted "bitch I'll bleed you". BATES responded "I ain't got time for that". BATES stated that the woman then "got to running up on me", grabbing BATES' hair. BATES stated that a security guard, who she could not identify, started holding her and choking her, and the woman began hitting BATES in the face. I asked whether BATES required medical attention and she stated she did not.

INVESTIGATION AT 2901 N. DR. WILLIAM FINLAYSON ST. (SAVOY'S)

After interviewing BATES we changed locations to 2901 N. Dr. William Finlayson St. to investigate at Savoy's. I spoke to a security guard, verbally identified as Kevin E. BLACKMAN (M/B 09/15/1988), and a barback, verbally identified as Alexzander K. LOVE (M/B 11/02/1992). P.O. WILLIAMS spoke to the owner of the property, Tina L. JOHNSON (06/01/1967).

LICENSED PERSON INVOLVED - SECURITY GUARD (BLACKMAN)

BLACKMAN is the security guard at the door at Savoy's. BLACKMAN was armed with a handgun in a holster across his chest. BLACKMAN stated that he did not observe any physical fight occur. BLACKMAN stated that he observed a verbal argument between individuals who he recognized as "regulars" but could not identify, and the victim BATES. BLACKMAN stated that as a matter of policy, when individuals are engaged in loud verbal arguments, both parties are ejected from the bar, and that he escorted BATES and the other parties out the door. BATES stated that he did not observe any physical altercation, but that he would not have been aware of anything that might have happened after exiting the door.

LICENSED PERSON INVOLVED - BARBACK (LOVE)

LOVE is employed as a barback at Savoy's. LOVE stated he knows the victim BATES and is friendly with her. LOVE stated that he did recall the incident where JOHNSON asked who would pay for the door, but that he did not recall any physical fight stemming from the incident. LOVE stated that he had observed that BATES was starting to annoy some of the patrons in the patio area. LOVE stated that he was trying to get BATES to go back into the main bar area to get her away from the individuals in the patio. LOVE stated that BATES then became upset with his efforts to get her to leave and slammed the door, prompting JOHNSON to ask who would pay for any damages to the door.

BUSINESS AGENT - OWNER (JOHNSON)

P.O. WILLIAMS and I spoke to JOHNSON regarding the incident. When we stated we were here regarding a fight at the location, JOHNSON appeared surprised, stating that there was no fight that had occurred here. I asked JOHNSON whether her niece had been at this location tonight. JOHNSON stated no niece had been here, but her granddaughter had been here, and had left around 10:30 P.M.

SECURITY FOOTAGE

JOHNSON allowed us to view security footage of the patio area where the incident was supposed to have occurred. The timestamps on the video were off, being 1 hour late. At 10:37 P.M. on the video (meaning 11:37 P.M. actual), I observed a M/B subject, wearing a light-colored T-shirt, and an apparent badge/necklace around his neck, approach BATES, grabbing her, and another unidentified subject, possibly M/B, approximately 5'09", 150lb, punching BATES in the face. Upon seeing this, JOHNSON appeared surprised, and asked to rewind the footage. I asked JOHNSON if she knew the two individuals attacking BATES. JOHNSON stated she did not.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 7/21/2026 at 11:10 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at <http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel>. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

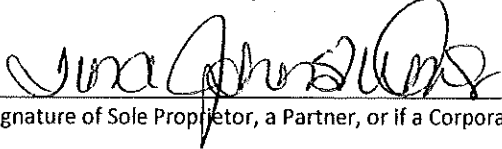
