## Legal Action of Wisconsin

- \$100,000 request
  - this allocation will provide funding for a full-time attorney to provide free legal representation to indigent person with tickets in Milwaukee Municipal Court.

## North Westside CDC

- \$600,000 request
  - this allocation will provide a match for a 1.67 Million grant from the Economic Development Administration (EDA). MWERC will establish a Energy Innovation Advanced Training & Development Center.
  - 100 residents trained and placed per year in the field of electrical assembly, test technicians and power engineers
- ***Recommendation: Fund at \$250,000***

## Dominican Center for Women

- \$500,000 request
  - this allocation will provide funding the Amani Block Project. 38 Units rehabilitated
  - Location: 2900 block of North 26th Street.
- ***Recommendation: Fund at \$500,000***

## Impact seven

- \$750,000 request
  - this allocation will provide gap funding for the Garden Homes Neighborhood Initiative.

## Community Within the Corridor

- \$1,000,000 request
  - this allocation will provide gap funding for the Community within the Corridor project
  - Mixed-use development, 197 Units
  - North 32nd Street plant of the former Briggs and Stratton Corporation
  - Financing: Tax Incremental District (\$3.15-million), WHEDA LIHTC (\$19.7-million), and Historic tax credits (\$17.4-million)
  - Location 32<sup>nd</sup>-33<sup>rd</sup> Center Street to West Hadley Street
- ***Recommendation: Fund at \$1,000,000***
