REASON FOR REQUEST:

Jeffrey Saporito, a City of Milwaukee DPW employee, was in the scope of his employment and operating a City of Milwaukee vehicle that was traveling northbound on South 15th Place in the City of Milwaukee. As the claimant's vehicle was proceeding through the intersection with West Rogers Street, the uninsured motorist, who was traveling westbound on West Rogers Street, disregarded a stop sign and collided with the passenger side of the City vehicle, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to § 62.67, Stats. and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Mr. Saporito sustained injuries to his neck, right shoulder and right hip. A cervical discectomy and fusion was performed at the C5-C6 level and there is a 10 percent permanent partial disability as a result of the neck injury and surgery. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$47,948.64.
