In 2017, under the STRONG Neighborhoods Plan, the Neighborhood Improvement Development Corporation (NIDC) completed the following:

- Community Outreach Events: NIDC staff attended 50 events promoting STRONG Neighborhoods Plan programs.
- STRONG Homes Loans

105 loans approved/closed (2017) \$1,596,932 of city investment (2017) 54 applications in process

Homebuyer Assistance Program (SNP-HBA)

3 loans approved/closed (2017) \$60,000 of city investment (leveraged additional \$196,000 of investment) (2017) 5 applications in process

Rental Rehabilitation Expansion Program (SNP-RR)

15 units (approved/closed) \$224,985 of city investment (leveraged additional \$421,551 of investment) 11 units (applications in process)
