There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines: Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 09/09/23 at 12:05pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3565 N Teutonia Av, for an entry complaint. Officers spoke with the agent who stated that a subject got in to the business after hours and took money from the business drawer. Officers reviewed the video of the incident. The video showed the suspect entering the business by breaking a window and taking property from the drawer of the business. Officers recovered some evidence from the scene and filed the incident as a burglary.
2. On 09/11/23 at 4:36am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3565 N Teutonia Av, for an entry complaint. Officers spoke with the agent who stated that a subject got into the business after hours by breaking a window and removed property. Officers reviewed video which showed the suspect's description and the incident in it's entirety. The suspect is believed to be the same suspect wanted for burglary which occurred to the business, a few days prior.

Upon arrival, I spoke to the caller identified as Pierre J NAUGLES B/M DOB 03/27/1989 who is an employee at 3565 N Teutonia Ave (Jacks Liquor). NAUGLES stated that the store has been having problems with an unknown male subject who frequently loiters around the store. NAUGLES stated that the male subject is panhandling outside the store and when they tell him to leave he becomes upset and starts making threatening statements. NAUGLES stated that this subject is a constant problem and is always at the lot panhandling and harassing customers. During my interview with NAUGLES he was cooperative during the investigation.

I also spoke to the manager of the establishment identified as Sukhjinder SINGH A/M DOB 01/01/1980 who stated that the male subject is always in front of the liquor store loitering and panhandling.

Officers made contact with the unidentified male subject who was currently at the Citgo gas station located at 3551 N Teutonia Ave. The male subject was told to leave the premises. The male subject then left.

During my investigation for The threat on scene I did not observe any violations in the licensed premise. I observed the food dealer and liquor licenses posted that expire on 07/01/2025.

The victim, verbally identified as Sukhjinder SINGH (W/M, DOB: 01-01-1980, residing at 3875 West Ryan Road, located in Franklin Wisconsin, phone number 414-865-8478) reported to the tele-communicator unknown subject was threatening him and stated he will stab the cashier.

Initial observation/ scene description

Upon arrival on the scene at approximately 2:36 PM, I observed a rectangular building with a large, paint "Jacks Liquor" on the west side of the street. The main entrance door was facing southbound. Police Officer GRAMS and I observed SINGH at the front entrance of the store along with the unidentified male subject. SINGH appeared distraught and upset as he began recounting the events that had transpired.

Interview of Victim (Sukh SINGH)

During the preliminary investigation, SINGH reported to Police Officer GRAMS the subject was patronizing the store for approximately twenty minutes without purchasing anything. SINGH reported he asked the individual to vacate the premises and the individual began slamming items on the counter. SINGH further reported the individual began making threats to harm the cashier and child behind the counter. SINGH reported this individual frequent his establishment and is always irate. SINGH reported he do not want this individual to patronize his business and would like restraining order information. Police Officer GRAMS provided SINGH with restraining order information and stated he did not want to prosecute. Police Officer GRAMS and I attempted to speak with the individual and he became very disruptive, using profanity and running onto the City transit bus. Informed SINGH if the subject goes into his business again to contact the Milwaukee Police Department.

The business did not have security officers on scene.
