- 1. David Zibolski claim dated April 23, 1998. The claim previously submitted did not include all pages of the bill. This incident involved allegations that detectives had battered a criminal defendant; our office represented Detective Zibolski at a suppression hearing to object to an in-court identification procedure which would be used to identify the detective who allegedly committed the battery. No charges were issued against Det. Zibolski.
- 2. Patrick Warren and Rick Bungert claim dated February 19, 1998. Your file did not include a bill. (Perhaps you cannot locate it because it is so small.)
