


The above-named police officer has retained us to represent him in connection with the above-referenced matter.

Dear Mr. Smokowicz:

Enclosed are a series of documents which relate to claims which this office has previously filed. In our telephone conversation of May 16, 2000, you indicated that these documents were not included with the claims when they were initially filed.

1. **David Zibolski claim dated April 23, 1998.** The claim previously submitted did not include all pages of the bill. This incident involved allegations that detectives had battered a criminal defendant; our office represented Detective Zibolski at a suppression hearing to object to an in-court identification procedure which would be used to identify the detective who allegedly committed the battery. No charges were issued against Det. Zibolski.

2. **Patrick Warren and Rick Bungert claim dated February 19, 1998.** Your file did not include a bill. (Perhaps you cannot locate it because it is so small.)

3. **Bodo Gajevic and Jason Smith claim of August, 1998.** Enclosed are dismissal notices regarding complaints by Marc Norfleet, Malcolm Norfleet, and Douglas Dunham against both Gajevic and Smith. The Dunham complaint was dismissed without a hearing; the Norfleets' complaints were consolidated for hearing; there are two decisions from the FPC dismissing their complaints.

4. **Gabe Sablica claim of December, 1998.** Enclosed is the dismissal notice.


5. **Kathryn Miller et al. claim of February 1998 re charges of Barbara Garner.** Enclosed are dismissal notices of Miller and each et al.

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
