

REASON FOR REQUEST:

Reginald Carthen, a City of Milwaukee police officer, was in the scope of his employment and a passenger in a City of Milwaukee squad car that was conducting a traffic stop at 5403 W. Hampton Avenue. During the traffic stop, the uninsured motorist, who was traveling eastbound on West Hampton Avenue, failed to yield the right-of-way and rear-ended the police vehicle, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Carthen sustained injuries to his neck, back, and right knee. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$5,232.71.
