<b>Property</b>	1801 N. PROSPECT Charles Allis Museum, an individually designated historic property
<b>Description of work</b>	One condenser had previously been installed on the north side of the Charles Allis Museum per COA dated 08-28-2007. Two additional condensers will be added at the same window well location. The physical size of the units will be approximately 29 inches high by 31 inches square. The new air handling unit in the basement will connect through an existing outside air duct so no new exterior wall penetrations will be made. The units will be screened by existing landscaping.

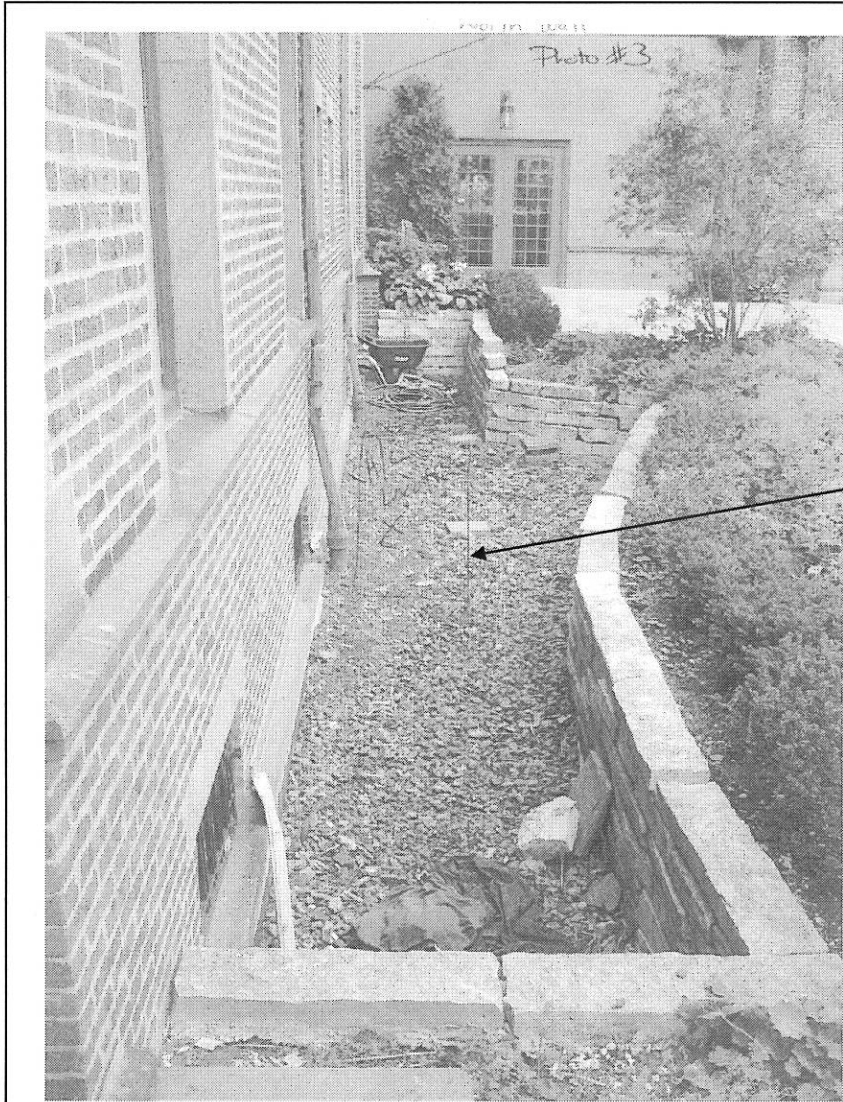

This photo from 2007 shows location of condensers.

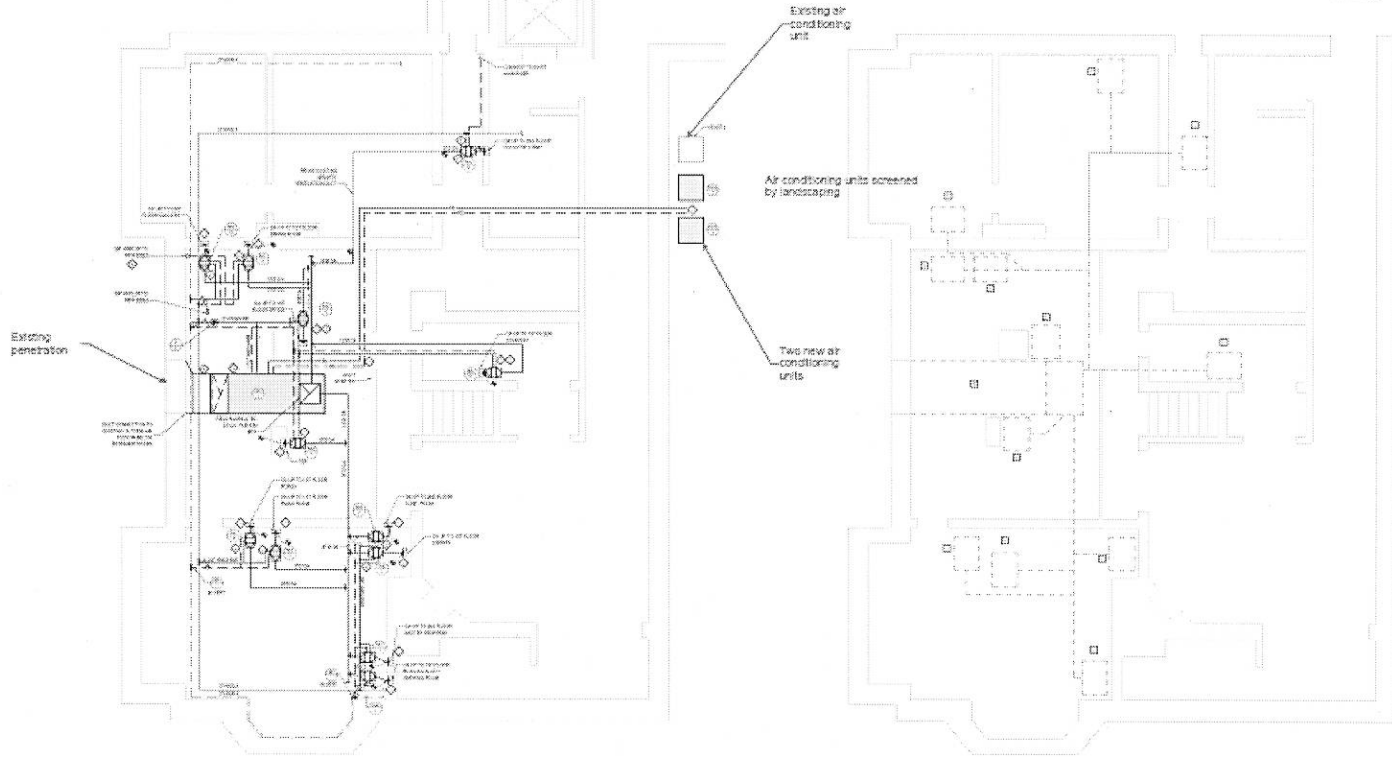
