There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.


You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

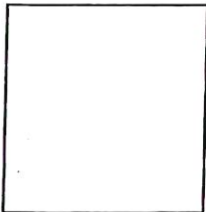

object to another renewal of liquor licensing for AJ King Drive Liquor. It was acknowledged in a previous hearing that *a liquor store should not exist less than 300 feet from a school or church* (established in WI Statute 125.68 (3)). With that understanding, a Love-owned liquor store at that address was still allowed, and continued licensing was granted.

Change of ownership should place most recent owners under the established guidelines, not to use the exemption of a previous owner. This would not allow them to operate next door, in the same structure, as the school and place established for religious purposes.

I would appreciate a response to the issue raised above. In 2017 when [redacted] decided that she no longer wanted AJ King Liquor Store, that should have "closed the chapter" of the liquor store being allowed to open and operate next door to a school and place of worship. These had been establishments on the corner of Third and Wright from the early 1970's.

writing to formally express my opposition to the renewal of the liquor license for the establishment known as "A Malt & Class Liquor," which also operates under the name "AJ King Drive Liquor" on Martin Luther King Jr. Drive.

ongoing issues associated with this business that negatively impact the surrounding community. The store frequently attracts individuals who congregate outside the property, creating excessive noise, littering throughout the area, and often behaving in ways that disrupt the peace of the neighborhood. Many customers leave trash such as bottles, wrappers, and other debris in nearby streets, yards, and sidewalks.

In addition, the presence of this liquor store raises serious concerns regarding public safety and community well-being. There have been incidents of violence in the surrounding area, including shootings along Martin Luther King Jr. Drive in recent years. For example, police investigated a shooting on the 2400 block of N. Martin Luther King Jr. Drive in June 2025 where a 31-year-old victim was injured. Situations like this contribute to an environment that residents do not feel safe in.

Another major concern is the proximity of a school located right next to this establishment. It is troubling that a liquor store with these types of ongoing disturbances operates so close to a place where children are present daily. The behavior of some customers—who are sometimes intoxicated or otherwise not acting responsibly—creates an environment that is not appropriate or safe for students, families, or the surrounding community.

Overall, I strongly believe that renewing the liquor license for this business would continue to contribute to the problems our neighborhood faces rather than improving them. Our community deserves businesses that contribute positively to the area, respect the residents who live here, and help create a safer environment for families and children.

For these reasons, I respectfully request that the City carefully review the impact this establishment has had on the neighborhood and consider denying the renewal of its liquor license.

On Sunday August 10th at 1:32 pm, I was dispatched to 2469 N Martin Luther King Dr located in the City and County of Milwaukee for a shooting. *This had nothing to do with the business other than it occurred in front of the business and their video surveillance captured the incident.*

Upon my arrival, I observed red brick store located in the 2400 block on the west side of N. Martin Luther King Dr. There were approximately 9 squad cars on scene blocking the north and southbound lanes of N. MLK Dr. and the east and westbound lanes of N. Wright St.

I spoke to the caller, who was verbally identified as Damon R. RICHMOND Jr. (B/M 04/11/2006) who stated he heard a gunshot and called the police.

I spoke to licensed premise employees who were verbally identified as Rohith NADUKUDA (A/M 05/01/2001) who stated that he did not see the incident occur. NADUKUDA stated that he saw the victim on the ground, but believed he was sleeping. The other employee was verbally identified as Reddy D. KALLURI (A/M 07/31/2001) who stated he was in the back of the store and did not see anything.

The business was cooperative with the investigation. The business did not have any security officers on scene.

Other officers reviewed video surveillance footage. The video was inventoried to Evidence.com

While on scene, I observed the licenses posted and they were up to date. During my investigation for a shooting, I did not observe any violations in the licensed premise.

You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.


