THIS REPORT IS SUBMITTED BY P.O. CHAUNCEY HARRIS ASSIGNED TO DISTRICT 5 COMMUNITY PROSECUTION UNIT. ON LISTED DATE AND TIME MYSELF ALONG WITH DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE AGENT GEORGEANN KING AND TWO CIVILIAN REVENUE AGENTS RESPONDED TO 2526 W. HOPKINS STREET TO CONDUCT A BUSINESS CHECK. AGENT KING INFORMED MYSELF AND MY PARTNER P.O. MICHAEL DRISCOLL THEIR DEPARTMENT WAS CONDUCTING A TOBACCO COMPLIANCE CHECK AS WELL AS RECORDS CHECKS REGARDING OWNERSHIP OF THE BUSINESS. THE BUSINESS IS KNOWN AS FREEZ FOOD MART. UPON ARRIVAL WE MADE CONTACT WITH RAMI FARES WHO IDENTIFIED HIMSELF AS THE MANAGER OF THE STORE. A CHECK OF THE LICENSE SYSTEM REVEALED THE TOBACCO AND FERMENTED ALCOHOL LICENSES WERE CURRENT. I CONDUCTED A CHECK OF RAMI FARES AND HE HAD NOT RENEWED HIS CLASS B MANAGER LICENSE. FARES STATED HE WOULD RENEW THE LICENSE, STATING HE LET IT EXPIRE BECAUSE THEY DO NOT SELL BEER. OFFICERS DID NOT LOCATE ANY FERMENTED BEVERAGES IN THE STORES STORAGE OR DISPLAY AREA. FARES WAS NOT CITED AT THIS TIME FOR THIS. AGENT KING DID INFORM ME SHE HAD LOCATED SEVERAL TOBACCO PRODUCTS IN THE STORES INVENTORY THAT FARES DID NOT HAVE PROPER DOCUMENTATION FOR. AGENT KING INFORMED ME FARES DID WILLINGLY ADMIT TO HER HE AND HIS BROTHER HAD PURCHASED SEVERAL DIFFERENT BRANDS OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS FROM A UNDOCUMENTED SELLER. AGENT KING DID SEIZE THE PRODUCTS.  - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.


