

Please be advised that the Electrical Workers and their Contractors have an agreement providing for the following rates of wages and fringe benefits **effective June 1, 2002.**

Employer contribution paid into the **Health and Welfare Trust Fund** for Electrical Mechanic, Electrician Foreman and Electrician General (Area) Foreman is Three Dollars (\$5.60) per hour and is paid on all clock hours, effective June 1, 2002.

Employer contributions paid into the **Vacation and Holiday Trust Fund** are as follows on the basis of ten percent (10%) of gross earnings, hourly contribution for time worked at the straight time, effective June 1, 2002.
