Dear Honorable Members:

Returned herewith is Common Council Resolution File Number 030419, being a petition for a special privilege submitted by Floyd Berggren for groundwater monitoring wells that are located within the public right-of-way in the vicinity of 709-33 East Capitol Drive.

The request is to keep and maintain two flush-mounted groundwater monitoring wells, both located in the roadway area on the east side of North Fratney Street, south of East Capitol Drive. The wells will be used to conduct a long-term environmental assessment of the site for the potential migration of petroleum products through groundwater in conjunction with the Wiscons in Department of Natural Resources groundwater quality monitoring activity.

We are not aware that these monitoring wells have had and we do not believe that they will have an adverse effect on the general use of the public right-of-way. When these monitoring wells are no longer needed, the grantee shall undertake the steps necessary to insure their proper abandonment. We have, therefore, prepared the attached special privilege resolution, which, if adopted, will allow the monitoring wells to occupy the public right-of-way.
