There is a possibility that your application may be committee regarding the application shall be based on ince presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Limited parking for persons attending meetings in City Hall is available at reduced rates (5 hour limit) at the Milwaukee Center on the southwest corner of East Kilbourn and North Water Street. Parking tickets must be validated in the first floor information booth in City Hall.



The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 4/28/2015 at 10:00 AM, in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

This report is written by P.O Francisco J CARTAGENA assigned to district 2 on the late power shift.

On MON, 3-23-15, at 7:51pm, while in squad 2450 with P.O Eulia KAZACHENKO, we responded to 1945 S Muskego Av, to conduct a follow up regarding and R.E.S incident, which stemmed from Club El Patron, located at 2000 S 13th St.

In the incident a H/M was shot in the abdomen outside of Club El Patron. The victim of the shooting was identified as Oscar E HERRERA, H/M, 10-26-74.

On arrival I spoke to the Licensee of the establishment Esmeralda NAVA, W/F, 11-19-84. NAVA indicated she was at the location at the time of the incident. NAVA stated she did not see who was the shooter or why it happened. NAVA stated her husband, Angel LUEVANO, W/M, 11-15-74, alerted her to the trouble brewing between two groups she referred to as "Vaqueros" and "Cholos". Vaqueros is" the Spanish word use to describe a "Cowboy" and "Cholo" she use to describe a gang member. Both groups were inside the club but at the different locations inside the club. NAVA stated she observed an older subject wearing a cowboy hat go into the bathroom followed by two other subjects with baldheads. NAVA stated as subjects crossed path they intentionally bump shoulders, when she observed that she told them she did not want any problems at her establishment to which they replied there was no problem. NAVA stated both groups were at the club with females. NAVA stated at around 2:15am, she began to tell people to finish their drinks because she was closing at 2:30am. NAVA stated prior to her making the announcement she had observed the a few of the guys from the "cowboy" group leave out with the females then return about 15 minutes later. NAVA stated she had her security guard search the people that left and returned to the club. NAVA stated she was in the process of cleaning up to began the closing process when she heard what she thought was two gun shots then a little while later three more gunshots. NAVA stated her security guard closed the door and locked it. NAVA stated she feared that the people shooting would come into her club. NAVA stated while the shots were going off the group she reffered to before as the Vaqueros was still in the club. NAVA stated she heard loud banging on the door, she feared someone was hurt so she opened it. NAVA stated when she open the door she observed a older Hispanic male laying on the ground. NAVA stated she told one of her employee to call the Police. There are no surveillance cameras in or out of the club. Although I did not speak to her at her place of business she did cooperate with me by speaking to me about the incident. Det WOODEN and Det Young are currently conducting the investigation regarding this shooting.

By the time Police arrived on scene the Club was already closed.

Investigation revealed no shots were fired but that two subjects were cut by bottles from patrons who had exited the tavern. This report was written by P.O. Roman MARTINEZ, assigned to District Two/Late Power Shift.

On Monday, February 9th, 2015, at approximately 11:26PM, Squad 2440 (P.O. CONTRERAS/P.O. MARTINEZ) conducted a License Premise check of "Jesse's Place" (1933 W Windlake Av). Upon arrival, officers observed the establisment to be open and in operation at the time. Upon entering the tavern, there were no patrons present and only the bartender, Ayshe AHMED (I/F 08-08-78), was present. AHMED stated that she was the wife of the owner, Jaswinder SINGH, and was planning on closing the business early at midnight due to having no customers. Officers then checked the posted licenses and located the Class "B" Tavern license (BTAV 202397) which indictated an expiration date of 7-29-15.

I asked AHMED if she had a Class "D" Operators license which AHMED replied yes and stated that she forgot to post it with the other licenses. AHMED stated that she has a copy upstairs in the residental part of the building where she lives. I informed AHMED that she will need to have it posted and that I will verfiy her license with the LIRA database at a later time.

Due to the posted Class "B" Tavern license expiration date of 07-29-15, no citation was issued at the time of the tavern check and follow-up was conducted with CPU.

On Tuesday, Febuary 10th, 2015, I was informed by P.O. VELAZQUEZ (District Two, Community Prosecution Unit) that this business was operating without a valid Class B Tavern and Public Entertainment Premises License since August 22nd, 2014. The City Of Milwaukee License division mailed two notification letters on August 8th, 2014 and August 22nd, 2014 to the owner and agent, Jaswinder SINGH (A/M 04-06-66, 1933 W Windlake Av) regarding the issues with the license status, which resulted in the license being rendered null and void. Due to the tavern being observed in operation on 10-17-14 and on 02-09-15 with a suspended license, the licensee, SINGH was issued two citations for 90-3-1, Liqour License Required.

Officers along with Squad 2411 (Sgt. SCHLEI) delivered the citations to 1933 W Windlake Av on 02/10/15 at approximately 10:15PM and provided them to SINGH's wife, Ayshe AHMED (I/F 08-08-78). AHMED stated that SINGH is currently outside the country at the moment. AHMED stated that they were unaware of the license status being suspended and never obtained any letter notification regarding the license status. Officers then provided AHMED with copies of both notification letters. AHMED indictated that she was in charge of the business while her husband, SINGH, was out of town and will attempt to correct issues with the City Clerk License Division the following day.

After informing AHMED of the suspended license status, per Sgt. SCHLEI authority, Officers instructed AHMED that the establishment had to be closed due to the license issue. AHMED cooperated and closed down the business.

A check with LIRA database afterwards revealed that AHMED's Class "D" license was expired on 01-02-2014 and AHMED has no Class "B" Manager's License. AHMED is an immediate famliy member (Wife) of the licensee, SINGH, and resides at the same address of SINGH.

Further Follow-Up will be conducted with this establishment to insure that they are incomplaince and not operating without a valid license.

This report was written by P.O. Roman MARTINEZ, assigned to District Two/Late Power Shift. On Friday, October 17, 2014, at approximately 8:54PM, Squad 2230 (P.O. SZYMBORSKI/P.O. FRANK), Squad 2211 (Sgt. SAWYER), and Squad 2290 (P.O. BESAW/P.O. GLORIA) responded to a Subject with Gun complaint (CAD#142902520) at S 19th St/W. Windlake Av. According the anonymous caller (Refused P#), they stated that multiple gang members (Latin Kings) where inside the location named "Jesse's Tavem". The anonymous caller stated that he observed one Hispanic male subject with a gun tucked in the back of his pants and another Hispanic male subject dealing drugs inside the location.

Upon police arrival, several subjects outside the tavern left in vehicles and additional subjects exited the tavern and left the location. While squads were investigating inside the tavern, officers located two silver .40caliber Smith & Wesson semi-automatic handguns inside the tavern. Officers located one handgun in the garbage can inside the men's restroom and the other handgun in a separate garbage can in the southwest corner of the tavern. Squad 2479 (P.O. MARTINEZ/P.O. WARD) responded to assist with the investigation and file a tavern report regarding this incident. Squad 2230 recovered the handguns and inventoried them at District Two. Squad 2211 (Sgt SAWYER) then instructed the tavern to be closed for the remainder of the night.

I spoke with an Auyshe I. AHMED (W/F 08-08-78, 1933 W Windlake Av) who stated that she was the owner of the tavern. AHMED stated that the event at the tavern was a fundraiser for a Socorro KERNER (W/F 08-10-79), who is an alleged female Latin King gang member, that is currently in jail/prison and the funds were to afford a defense lawyer. AHMED stated that there were no issues inside the tavern that night and there were children present with family inside the establishment. AHMED stated that they were selling food to raise money for the fundraiser. AHMED stated that she was unaware that there were any weapons inside the tavern and was surprised that police located two handguns. I also spoke with the bartender, Elena S. GARCIA (W/F 04-14-82) who also stated the same as AHMED and was unaware of any weapons. AHMED stated that she also hired an unarmed bouncer/security guard to assist with checking people and monitoring the bar. The tavern was open to the public and also had a live DJ playing music inside the tavern. I advised AHMED that a tavern report will be filed and follow-up regarding the licenses will be conducted and possible citations issued.

I checked the licenses of the tavern, which were posted, and observed that the entertainment section of the BTAV license listed 1 jukebox, 1 pool table, and 1 amusement machine. I observed in addition to the listed items a dartboard and 3 additional amusement machines with the tavern but were currently turned off at the time.

While at District Two, I checked the tavern's license (BTAVN 202397) on LIRA and discovered that it was Not Current (SUSPENDED) and was issued, Status Date: 8/22/14. There was another BTAVN license attached to the location (BTAVN 189558) which indicated RENEWAL - Permanent license issued, Status Date: 7/28/14.

This information will be forwarded to CPU for further follow-up investigation.
