I lost an enormous amount of Clothes, Shoes, Carpet, baby items and a Oriental Rug which was of Sentimental Value.

It Caused much of a big inconvenience due to not being able to wash or bathe, every time my family ran water in any area the basement would increase with Sewer water for 5 days until the plumber came to Sewer averaging 6 2/3 of water. The smell was horrible not to mention the Clean-up. There's still remence of mildew.

However, I did submit a ~~11,000.00~~^{claim} to the Housing Manager. Unfortunately Housing doesn't honor Sewer back-up Claims, pitcheins were taken but Housing has them in their possession.

It would be greatly appreciated if the City would Consider Compensating my loss.
