File # 071022 is a resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of an Advanced Training Grant.

## **Background**

- 1. This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) to apply for, accept and fund an Advanced Training Grant from the State of Wisconsin Department of Justice (DOJ), Training and Standards Bureau.
- 2. This is a continuing grant. On September 26, 2006 the Common Council adopted CCFN 060603 that authorized MPD to accept \$169,350 from Wisconsin DOJ to provide advanced training classes, including police ethics, supervision for police personnel and diversity training.

# **Discussion**

- 1. The purpose of this grant is to provide an advanced training course titled "Surviving And Thriving On The Job."
- 2. MPD officers, to be determined, will participate in 10 one-day classes at the Milwaukee Police Academy from February 4 through February 15, 2008.
- 3. This grant will cover the costs for the instructor and materials for the training sessions and encompasses the period of July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008.

### Fiscal Impact

1. The total amount of this grant is \$23,000 entirely from the grantor.
