SONY OF THE WARREN

On February 2, 2004 at 1:50pm I stopped at a red light on Green Bay Road. I was in the left turn lane, ready to take the ramp onto Silver Spring Dr. (west). When I stopped, I saw a worker snow blowing the sidewalk on the East side of the bridge. No other cars were present. When the light changed, I put in my clutch and shifted my car into gear. Before I even moved at ALL or even stepped on the gas, I heard a loud grinding noise on the right side of my car. As I turned to look I was shocked to see it was the worker with the snow blower grinding right against my right rear wheel and fender. When I put on my hazard lights and got out of my car, the worker just backed up, then went around my car and kept going like nothing happened. He would not even acknowledge me or what he just did. I had to walk half a block to the city truck and Corey Tipton from Sewer Maintenance 286-3427 helped me. He held the traffic back so I could move my car from the left turn lane across the other two lanes and out of traffic. He was a witness that my car was standing still.

I was able to obtain the worker's name once the police and the City of Milwaukee accident inspector arrived. The city worker that drove the snow blower into the side of my car was MICHAEL CASBERG, born 7/13/50, home phone 643-8618 work phone 286-3786. At the time of the accident, Mr. Casberg had on sunglasses, a brimmed hat, and ear protectors. Mr. Casberg gave three different responses to the accident. First, he said he did not see my car! My fire red car was standing still 3 lanes away from him, hard to believe he didn't see this car! Second, He said Well you had a green light, The light did turn green but he hit me before I could even move! Third, He said I hit him. Both the police and the city accident inspector said the only way I could have hit him (based on my car's damage) was if I was traveling sideways. My car was damaged only by the right rear wheel and fender where the snow blower made contact.

I believe Mr.Casberg did not have control of the snow blower as he went from snow covered sidewalks to the snowless street. He was going too fast for the change in the surfaces, lost control, and negligently hit my car. I was particularly upset with Mr. Casberg's attitude. He acted like nothing happened, would take no responsibility for his actions, and was going to leave the scene, but the Glendale police arrived just in time as did the City of Milwaukee accident inspector, Mr. Brian Field. Mr. Field took pictures of my car. I also took pictures if needed. The Glendale police officer that helped me and did file a report was Officer Erik Johnson, phone 228-1100.

I took my car to the body shop for an estimate of damages with in 2 hours. I am enclosing the estimate and the cards of Officer Johnson and Inspector Brian Fields Police Report.

I, Michalynn Orlowski, am a MPS Speech Pathologist working on the job for 26 years. I worked very hard and saved for 14 years to buy my DREAM car. Not easy to do on a public school teacher's salary! I feel hurt, mad, abused, by Mr. Casberg's negligent damage to my car. I am filing this claim for reimbursement for the negligent damage to my car. I truly appreciate any help in getting this matter resovled.
