Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

This report is written by Police Officer Carlos Felix, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 12/21/2018 officers were dispatched to a fight at Denny's restaurant, 3801 S 27th St. The investigation revealed two employees were fighting inside the restaurant. The manager wanted citations issued because the fight occurred in view of the public. Both subjects were issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct and they were fired by the manager.

2. On 07/11/20, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to Denny's Restaurant, 3801 S. 27th St., for a fraud complaint. Investigation revealed two patrons left without paying the bill totaling \$75.76. Management allowed officers to view the surveillance of the suspects and suspect vehicle leaving the scene. Management was cooperative with police.
 3. On 11/15/20, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to Denny's, 3801 S. 27th St., for a fight. Investigation revealed there was a confrontation between patrons and the suspect threw plates at the other patron and tore a decoration off the wall, causing damage. The uncooperative suspect remained on scene and was cited for vandalism. Management was cooperative with police.

4. On 03/19/2021 at 10:56pm officers were dispatched to a Fight at Denny's, 3801 S 27th St. The officers spoke with the manager, who stated there was a large fight in the dining area but all the subject were now gone.
5. On 03/26/2021 at 3:43am officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at Denny's, 3801 S 27th St. The officers spoke with the employee who stated there was a group of people being loud and refusing to leave. The officer made several attempts to get the subjects to leave but they refused until the officer threatened to arrest them for Trespassing and Disorderly Conduct. The subject then left in an auto but threatened to run the officer over.
6. On 05/02/2021 at 10:23pm officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at Denny's, 3801 S 27th St. The officer spoke with the manager, who stated a subject was sleeping in a booth and refused to leave. The officer attempted to wake the subject but were unsuccessful. The officer called MFD and they conveyed the subject to the hospital for treatment for intoxication.
7. On 07/19/2021 at 6:49am officers were dispatched to a Fraud at Denny's, 3801 S 27th St. The officer interviewed a waitress, who stated a subject ordered food and left without paying for the items. The subject left on foot but got on the bus prior to the arrival of the police.
8. On 12/14/2021 at 10:16pm officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at Denny's, 3801 S 27th St. The officers spoke with the manager, who asked for a subject to be removed from the business. The officers removed the subject and advised him to not return.
9. On 12/21/2021 at 8:29pm officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at Denny's, 3801 S 27th St. The officer spoke with an employee, who wanted a subject removed for not paying and sleeping on the bench for an hour. The subject was conveyed to the hospital for medical treatment.

10. On 03/26/23 at 11:10pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3801 S. 27th St, for a trouble with subject complaint. Officers spoke with the manager who stated that she had to terminate an employee. The employee then engaged in a verbal argument with the manager. The employee left prior to police arrival. The manager was advised to call the police if the subject returns, and a citation could be issued.
11. On 04/01/23 at 9:52pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3801 S. 27th St, for a subject with gun complaint. Officers spoke with the manager who stated that a group of customers got into a verbal altercation with another customer at a different table. The single subject at one point stated that he was going to get his gun from his vehicle. The subject returned and acted like he had a gun in waist band. Both parties eventually paid their food bills and left with no further incident. No handgun was observed by staff.
12. On 04/03/23 at 9:40pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3801 S. 27th St, for a damaged to property complaint. The manager stated that an employee damaged the door to the business. The incident was captured on video but the manager could not provide it for officers, at that particular time.
13. On 04/13/23 at 2:34am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3801 S. 27th St, for an armed robbery complaint. The caller stated that he was robbed at knife point. Police arrived at the location and the business was not cooperative with officers regarding the incident. Staff did not

answer questions asked by the officer regarding the incident. Eventually officers discovered the business had nothing to do with the complaint, and the caller just used the business phone to call for the police.

14. On 04/27/23 at 3:00am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3801 S. 27th St, for an injured/sick complaint. The caller stated that a person is in the parking lot laying on the ground. Officers located the subject who was not responsive and it was determined he was overdosing. Officers administered Narcan and Milwaukee Fire arrived at the location, and transported the subject to the hospital for further medical evaluation.
15. On 05/01/23 at 12:38am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3801 S. 27th St, for suspicious/other complaint. Officers arrived at the business and it appeared to be opened but no employees were on scene. Officers got a hold of the key holder and the manager stated that she thought she closed the business properly but had the wrong keys. The business is not opened after 12:00am on Sunday or Mondays.
16. On 05/19/23 Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3801 S. 27th St, for an injured/sick complaint. Officers spoke to the caller who stated that he fell outside the location and wanted to go to the doctor. The caller was conveyed to the hospital by ambulance.
17. On 05/21/23 Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3801 S. 27th St, for loud music complaint. Officers did not locate the vehicle playing the loud music and there was no answer on call back to the complainant.
18. On 05/22/23 at 3:30pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3801 S. 27th St, for a fight complaint. Officers spoke with the caller who was a grub hub driver, and stated that an intoxicated subject struck him in the face several times. Both subjects fought in the lobby area of the business. The victim stated that he would seek medical attention on his own. The business was cooperative with the investigation providing video and witness statements. The suspect was transported to the hospital and issued citations regarding the incident.
19. On 06/15/23 at 3:09am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3801 S. 27th St, for a trouble with subject complaint. Officers spoke with the caller who stated that a subject was in the restaurant refusing to leave. The subject was at the location for the last four hours. Officers located the subject and advised her that the management wanted her to leave the premise. The subject gathered her belongings and left without any further incident.
20. On 07/09/23 at 5:12am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3801 S. 27th St, for a fraud complaint. Officers spoke to the manager who stated that five subjects left without paying for their food. The subjects left in three different vehicles. The manager stated that he captured the incident on video. The security was off duty at the time of the theft.
21. On 08/04/23 at 4:09am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3801 S. 27th St, for an armed robbery complaint. Officers spoke with the manager who stated that a suspect armed with a handgun demanded the money from the cash register. The suspect obtained money and exited the business south from the location. Video that captured the incident was recovered as evidence.
22. On 11/05/23 Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3801 S. 27th St, for a battery complaint. Officers arrived and located a subject unable to get up from the floor. Investigation revealed that the subject was intoxicated and a fight did not occur.

23. On 11/28/23 at 12:48am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3801 S. 27th St, for a welfare check. Officers spoke with a subject inside the restaurant that seemed to be in distress. The subject stated he was faint and dizzy, then became irate hitting a chair inside the location. Officers conveyed the subject to the hospital for medical and mental evaluations. The business was cooperative with the investigation.
24. On 12/09/23 at 4:22am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3801 S. 27th St, for a subject with gun complaint. Officers spoke to the suspect who stated that she fired her gun in the air to stop a fight, then during the altercation her gun was stolen. The suspect's action resulted in Reckless Endangering Safety and the suspect was detained for the incident. Investigation revealed that a fight occurred between her party and another party. The suspect fired one shot in an attempt to stop the fight. During the commotion the suspect was wrestled to the ground and her gun was taken by people from the other party. The business was cooperative with the investigation providing video of the incident and witness statements from staff.
25. On 01/27/24 at 7:08am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3801 S. 27th St, for a threat complaint. Officers spoke with the manager who stated that an employee on video stole money from the safe. The supervisor was going to allow the employee to return the money but the employee had not returned phone calls. The business was cooperative with the investigation and provided video of the theft.
26. On 01/30/24 at 1:35am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3801 S. 27th St, for a theft complaint. Officers spoke with the employee who stated that a group of six ate at the business but only two subjects of the six paid for their meals. The other subjects left the location without paying. The theft was not captured on security cameras.
27. On 03/05/24 at 3:35am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3801 S. 27th St, for a trouble with subject complaint. Officers arrived and were informed by the manager that the subject just left prior to officer's arrival. The subject initially refused to leave after smoking in the restaurant area.

28. On 02/21/25 at 2:31p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Theft at 3801 S. 27th St. Investigation revealed the business called due to patrons walking out without paying their bill. The business was cooperative.
29. On 03/04/25 at 3:15 AM, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 3801 S. 27th St, for a Trouble with subject complaint. An unknown subject approached two customers in the business and made statements that caused them to fear for their safety. No business violations were observed.
30. On 03/21/25 at 6:10a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at 3801 S. 27th St. Investigation revealed the business was the victim of a theft. The business was cooperative.
31. On 03/29/25 at 12:45p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Theft at 3801 S. 27th St. Investigation revealed the business was the victim of a theft by an ex-employee. The business was cooperative.

32. On 04/01/25 at 2:45a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at 3801 S. 27th St. Officers were advised a subject was agitated and throwing things in the restaurant and may have been in mental health crisis. On arrival the subject refused to comply and took a boxer's stance, resulting in a Use of Force. Several employees would not speak to officers regarding the incident, they called police services for.
33. On 04/27/25 at 12:54a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shots Fired at 3801 S. 27th St. The caller stated a large group of people were in the rear of the business firing shots into the air. On arrival no one was observed in the rear and no casings were found. An armed security guard stated they did not hear or see anything. The business was cooperative.

34. On 05/30/25, at 2:38 a.m., Milwaukee Police received a Trouble with subject complaint. A manager requested officers remove a subject that was loitering in the business for several hours. The subject complied and left without incident.

The subject stated they found a bug in their food and refused to pay. The manager did not want to prosecute and requested that the subjects be removed from the business.

A security guard reported a large group in the business engaged in a physical fight which carried out to the parking lot. While subjects were fleeing in vehicles several gun shots were heard. The victim at the hospital was being treated for knife wounds.

The officer was able to contact one of the subjects and advise them that the business did not want them back on the property. The subject stated that some of the food was raw and a friend decided they would not pay for the meals, but he would go back and pay the bill.

Upon arrival, I spoke with the 911 caller, April GUTIERREZ (W/F 04/28/1986). April stated today her soon to be ex-husband entered the business and was demanding money \$30 from her. April GUTIERREZ did not want him in the business and told him he was trespassing. April GUTIERREZ stated she was not harmed, was not fearful for her safety and just wanted information on how to apply for a restraining order prior to her divorce being final in June of 2026.

The ex-husband was identified as Marcus G GUTIERREZ (M/H 05/02/1988). Marcus GUTIERREZ was not on scene once officers had arrived. Marcus GUTIERREZ had sent April GUTIERREZ text messages saying he was on the way, wanted \$30 and demanded April GUTIERREZ make him a hamburger with onion rings. April GUTIERREZ was provided the restraining order information along with a case number.

During the course of the investigation Marcus GUTIERREZ called April GUTIERREZ and stated to her " are we good? is this how we are doing this?". This implied he was still in the area and observed officers in the establishment. Officer Rafael LOPEZ and I exited the business, and we observed a man across the street at a bus stop who may have matched the description of the subject. The subject immediately got onto a Milwaukee County Transit system (MCTS) bus and went north in the 3800 block of south 27th street.

The staff at DENNY'S were cooperative during the investigation, provided all the information we would need to conduct a thorough investigation and had their licenses which were up to date and observed.

At approximately 5:35 A.M. I placed a phone call to Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) District 4 and placed a patrol watch on April GUTIERREZ residence. I spoke with Office Assistant BYFIELD who entered the patrol watch. I called April GUTIERREZ 5:41 A.M and advised her the watch was entered on her residence.

Upon arrival there were no one outside the restaurant and no one appeared to be in distress.

I attempted to speak to the caller however there was no answer on multiple call backs. It was later revealed the caller was at St. Luke's hospital who stated there was an argument at the Denny's parking lot and is the location where she was attacked.

There were no witnesses on scene at the time of police arrival.

It should be noted that the Denny's security guard police spoke with on scene after the incident stated he did not witness the incident. However security camera shows him on scene during the time of the incident.

I spoke to licensed premise (night time) manager, identified as April GUTIERREZ (W/F, 04/28/1986, phone# 414-915-0382) who stated that there was no fight or argument that occurred inside the establishment that this was the first time hearing about anything happening.

I was unable to review camera footage as the head manager who had access was not on scene. I later spoke to the day shift manager identified as Silvia MARIN (W/F, 02/22/1971) who stated that she had given the head manager our information so she can forward the video footage via e-mail. I asked MARIN if I could have the contact information for the head manager however she refused. It should be noted that however that in later camera footage the security guard appeared to pick up an item from the parking lot, close to the incident location. Please see P.O. PARK's supplemental report regarding full camera footage which was recovered at a later time.

While on scene, I observed the licenses posted and they were up to date.

MARIN was able to provide a license plate number for the vehicle that the customers left in. That plate was BCP-5403 and lists to a 2006 Toyota Corolla Matrix.

A search of D.O.T. revealed that vehicle's listed owner is Thaddeus N J ORTIZ BROWN (w/m 4-26-2005). I changed locations to the address of 2223 S 59th ST, West Allis. This is the address to where the vehicle and vehicles owner is registered. At the address I was able to make contact with ORTIZ and advised him of the situation. He stated that he was one of the four people that left without paying for the bill. He stated that some of their food was raw and his friend didn't want to pay for the bill, so the group decide to leave without paying for the bill. After more conversation ORTIZ stated that he would go back to the restaurant and pay for the bill. He stated that he understood that leaving was not the way to handle the situation. ORTIZ also stated that it was his 21st birthday and was intoxicated so he was not thinking clearly. I advised ORTIZ that he was no longer welcomed at the establishment but if he wanted to pay the bill to make contact with the manager.
