
This office is in receipt of your claim in the amount of \$1,226.59, relating to cost you in incurred for damages sustained to your vehicle when it was towed on October 17, 2003.

Our investigation reveals that your vehicle was towed on October 17, 2003 for being Illegally Parked. The PT-27 form, filled out prior to the tow, indicates minor damage throughout the vehicle. The Intake Video shows the front hood slightly elevated. Your vehicle was towed via flatbed. The damages claimed would not be caused as a result of towing or storage of a vehicle. As such, the City cannot accept liability. Accordingly, we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a letter within 21 days of the receipt of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Wells Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202, requesting a hearing.
