Our staff investigated this request and found that due to the narrowness of the roadway and the high amount of parked vehicles on West Harrison Avenue, that the flow of traffic is impeded on the roadway. Therefore, in an effort to improve the flow of traffic on West Harrison Avenue west of South 6th Street we recommend the installation of the above-captioned parking restriction.
