Subject: File 200639 follow up: DNC equipment purchases

The City of Milwaukee purchased various equipment to provide the Democratic National Convention security. Equipment, as defined by the grant, are items that cost more than \$5,000 per unit. Items that cost less than \$5,000 per unit are considered supplies. The Police department purchased twenty-seven (27) pieces of equipment and the Fire department purchased eighteen (18) pieces of equipment for a total of forty-five (45) pieces of equipment purchased by the City. The City expects to be reimbursed \$4,617,000 for these purchases. Attached to this memo are the details of the equipment purchases.
