

Around 3:00 PM, we heard a loud noise. The Milwaukee Police department was breaking down my door, @ 2909 West Clarke Street, 53210, Milwaukee in the County of Milwaukee, State of Wisconsin.

They held a gun in my face & in my stomach. Could not move, I was so scared that I wet on myself. The Officers (I guess the SWAT TEAM) came into my house, & torn up everything, my home looked as if a Tornado had came through there. They threw my husband on the floor (he ended up having to take 2 pills for his heart, so that he would not have another heart attack). It was just bad, real bad. I have been living @ 2909 W. Clarke St., for almost 30 years & nothing has happen like this to me or my family ever.

They threw clothes everywhere, candles, computer stand, knocked the computer down, knocked over the stereo, etc.. My grandmother use to live with me (she's deceased now) & in her room I still have all her little nick-knacks & such on her dresser & they proceeded to just knock everything on the floor, when looking

behine the dresser, breaking most of her things. Knocked my plants over, out of the dirt, digging in them, etc.

Broke the Christmas ornaments & lights, by just walking on them after they threw them out of there boxes onto the floor in the basement.

They torn off the screen door, knocked down the front door. It was torn off its' hinges. The door just looks as if it is up & locked, My Son, was able to put a few nails in there to keep it close. They took things that were not on the list that was on the warrant. My son is missing a lot of things out of his room also. At this time, my son was in the County Jail, up in Juneau, Wi...
