- Incremental property value generated: \$2.2 billion
- Incremental value represents 6.33% of the City's 2021 total Equalized Value
- Future project costs to be recovered are estimated at \$146,902,467



- Option for an additional \$7.9M if 790 additional jobs and additional space is added


