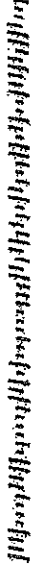


Dear Ms. Berrones:

This office is in receipt of your claim in the amount of \$1,756.57, relating to damage sustained to your vehicle on October 19, 2021 when you allege a City street sweeper backed into your vehicle at or near South 69th Street and West Ohio Avenue.

Our investigation reveals that the Fleet Division has no records relative to your vehicle damage allegedly caused by a City vehicle. Since no City driver has reported colliding with your vehicle, and you are unable to provide any information with respect to a City vehicle identification or license plate number, we are unable to verify a City vehicle was involved. As such, the City cannot accept liability. Accordingly, we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a letter within 21 days of the receipt of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Wells Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202, requesting a hearing.
