File # 011226 is a resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of a Beat Patrol Program Grant.

Background

1. This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) to apply for, accept and fund a Beat Patrol Program from the State of Wisconsin, Office of Justice Assistance.
2. This grant is continuing.

Discussion

1. The purpose of the Beat Patrol program is to work with neighborhood residents to identify and resolve crime and quality of life issues that impact upon the local area.
2. This grant funds 6 existing full time Police Officer positions for this program within the MPD 2nd District.
3. This grant encompasses the period of January 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002.

Fiscal Impact

1. The total amount of this grant is \$468,805 with \$150,000 provided by the grantor and \$468,805 provided by the city.
2. The city portion of this grant is included in the 2002 MPD operations budget.
