WHEREAS,

QWERTY MKE DAY

was recognized in conjunction with the QWERTYFest celebration in Milwaukee from June 23 to June 25, 2023 and also of the 150th anniversary of the production of the typewriter, an invention of Milwaukee; and

WHEREAS, The typewriter has had an enduring and massive impact on literature, communication, and information throughout both America and the entire world; and

WHEREAS, The first commercial typewriter, invented by Christopher Latham Sholes, a Milwaukee native, went into production for commercial manufacturing in 1873, 150 years ago, thus marking the creation of one of the most influential inventions of all time and the definition of the now-universal QWERTY keyboard layout; and

WHEREAS, QWERTYFest festivities were held in celebration of this momentous anniversary and of expression of the written word in general, including a weekend of parties, games, speaking events, live music, art exhibitions, and historical commemorations of the typewriter and its contributions to literature and technological development; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee herewith observes QWERTY MKE Day, commemorates the 150th anniversary of the invention of the typewriter in the city, and celebrates QWERTYFest; and, be it
