

2024 Southeast Wisconsin Threat Analysis Center (STAC) Intelligence and Infrastructure Protection Analyst

Allocation Purpose:

The grant will fund nine months of salary, fringe benefits, travel/training, and supply costs for an Intelligence and Infrastructure Protection Analyst, who will work in the Southeast Wisconsin Threat Analysis Center (STAC). The STAC, co-located with MPD's Intelligence Fusion Center, is an information-sharing center for the eight counties in southeastern Wisconsin including Milwaukee, Waukesha, Racine, Kenosha, Walworth, Ozaukee, Washington, and Dodge. The analyst will coordinate and develop intelligence and infrastructure protection products related to critical infrastructure and share with public and private sector and law enforcement partners.

Program Goals:

The STAC provides a platform for collaboration among multiple federal, state, local, and tribal agencies and disciplines to exchange information and intelligence, with the goal to improve the ability to detect, prevent, deter, and respond to crime and terrorism by analyzing data from various sources. The Intelligence and Infrastructure Prevention Analyst will coordinate with critical infrastructure representatives to conduct site visits and provide risk, threat, and vulnerability assessments.

Programmatic Summary:

The funding will fully cover nine months of salary and fringe benefits for the Intelligence and Infrastructure Protection Analyst, as well as travel, training, and supply costs.
