He joined a church in the City of Milwaukee and became dedicated to God in that ministry like never before. He became a servant to The Man that was placed over the church. His dedication through serving is what gave him a servant's heart. Kevin was then married to his wife, accepted The call to Pastor. He remembered what he said to his younger self and became a foster parent to countless children 2 of the children which are blood brother ages 8 & 9 they adopted as their own with complete name change. The changing of their names was significant and that's bond that bonded them to be the Men they are today. Kevin's work as a construction worker for many years that equipped him with the trade and skills where he led a federal program for the Milwaukee Urban League where he trained many Men & Women in the minority group within the City of Milwaukee. While he taught classes in the daytime, he also was the Lead Instructor for Trans to mentor homeless Women w children. He pastored over 500 families' members that changed countless lives. Kevin is such a selfless Man, he's pastored for Over 23yrs and has never taken a salary. His motto is that we walk by faith and not by sight. That means that his living is off what God provides daily.

Since April,2005 we've been on 33rd & Burleigh and have greatly impacted the community by providing a food pantry and housing to the families in the church and families in the community. We also provided back-to-school supplies, free haircuts, games, food and fun to bring the community together.
