Notice is hereby given that an
ordinance that was introduced at
the April 18, 2023 meeting of the
Milwaukee Common Council, the
essence of which is as follows:

A substitute ordinance relat-
ing to the change in zoning from
Industrial Light, IL2, to Down-
town-Mixed Activity, C9G, to allow
the development of a museum on
the properties located at 1310 and
1340 North 6th Street and 520
West McKinley Avenue, on the east
side of North 6th Street between
West Vliet Street and West McKin-
ley Avenue, in the 6th Aldermanic
District.

The Mayor and Common Council
of the City of Milwaukee ("Common
Council"), do ordain as follows:

Part 1. That is added to the Mil-
waukee Code of Ordinances a new
section to read as follows:

The zoning map is amended to
change the zoning for 1310 North
6th Street, Tax Key No. 361-0350-
100; 1340 North 6th Street, Tax
Key No. 361-0348-110; and 520
West McKinley Avenue, Tax Key
No. 361-0351-111, from Industri-
al Light (IL2) to C9G-Downtown
Mixed Activity (C9G).

Notice is hereby further given
that the foregoing matter will be
given a public hearing by the Com-
mittee on Zoning, Neighborhoods
and Development in Room 301-B,
City Hall, 200 East Wells Street,
Milwaukee, Wisconsin on Tuesday,
July 25, 2023, at 9:00 A.M., pur-
suant to the provision of Sub-sec-
tion (7)(d) of Section 62.23 of the
Revised Statutes of the State of
Wisconsin. This is also a virtual
