The proposed exterior envelope restoration project at Pabst Mansion is being undertaken to address ongoing maintenance and repairs of the aging exterior cladding.

The area of work for the exterior restoration project includes all building facades and roof of the Pabst Mansion and limited areas of the site. Removal of the east pavilion structure above the stone foundation was completed under a separate Certificate of Appropriateness (CFF 221875; issued 2/13/2024). The restoration work is to be completed in (2) phases spanning a three-year construction calendar due to funding considerations. The Phase 1 work is slated to start in spring of 2025 with a project completion of Phase 2 in 2027. The scope of the combined phases generally includes:
