3. On 03/26/2021 at 12:50pm officers were dispatched to a Subject with Gun complaint at 2812 W. Fond du lac Av. Officers interviewed the applicant, who stated a subject has been loitering and panhandling on the premise. The subject refuses to leave and has been bothering his customers. The applicant stated the subject got into a fight with a customer who was armed with a gun. The officer viewed video of the incident, which showed a subject armed with a gun hitting the panhandler. The officers spoke with the panhandler but he refused to speak with the officers. The officers asked for a copy of the video but the applicant stated the person that handles the video was out of town.
4. On 04/16/2021 officers conducted a license premise check at Citgo gas station, 2812 W. Fond du lac Av. The officers observed 3 video gambling machines with patron playing them. The officers spoke with the applicant by phone. The officer advised the applicant he needed a PEP license to operate the machines. The applicant stated the distributor had provided a license. The officer stated the applicant needed a PEP to operate the machines at his business. The applicant stated he would unplug the machines until he had a license.
5. On 06/15/2021 at 10:26pm officers conducted a license premise check at Citgo gas station, 2812 W. Fond du lac Av. The officer observed the licenses posted on the wall but did not see a cigarette license. The officer checked LIRA and found the business did have a valid license. The officer advised the applicant to post the current license.

6. On 08/10/22 at 9:06pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 2812 W. Fond Du Lac Avenue for a subject with gun compliant. Investigation revealed that the victim was at the filling station pumping fuel when another vehicle approached and pointed a gun at her. The victim went inside to ask the clerk for the address and he did not give it to her. Officers did not interview the clerk and video was recovered at a later date.

7. On 01/16/23 at 9:04p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shooting that occurred in the rear of 2844 N. 26<sup>th</sup> St. The victim of the shooting ran to 2812 W. Fond du Lac to seek help. Officers were able to view video surveillance and the victim was seen requesting help, however, none of the employees reached for a phone to assist, despite the victim bleeding inside the gas station. Further review of the video showed employees using a mop to clean up the blood on the floor. The officers attempted to interview a manager on scene, who was uncooperative and argumentative with officers.
8. On 05/15/23 at 8:45a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Fight at 2812 W. Fond du Lac. This was related to an automobile accident, unrelated to the business. The business was cooperative and allowed officers to view video surveillance, which captured the incident.
9. On 06/13/23 at 3:23a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shot Spotter at 2812 W. Fond du Lac. On arrival officers observed a large rock and a casing on the ground. Investigation revealed a subject locked themselves out of their vehicle and after numerous attempts to gain entry, the subject fired one shot in order to break the window and gain entry. The business was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident.
10. On 10/28/23 at 2:44p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shots Fired at 2816 W. Fond du Lac. On arrival the officer did not locate any casings, however, did recover a bullet

fragment. The officer attempted to view video surveillance at 2812 W. Fond du Lac, however the employee stated they did not have access to the system. The agent called the attendant and advised the officer via telephone that they reviewed the camera system from home and it did not show anything other than customers coming and going.

11. On 12/21/23 at 11:52a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at 2812 W. Fond du Lac. Investigation an unknown subject entered the business and stated they were with the City Inspector Office, however, could not provide credentials. The subject then stated they work with the Alderman, however, a phone call to the Alderman revealed the subject was not employed with their office. The subject was issued a contact card and advised not to return to the store.

12. On 06/27/24, a citizen walked in to the District for a Shots Fired, that occurred at 2812 W. Fond du Lac. The citizen stated they were at the gas station when suspects began to fire shots at a vehicle across the street. The victim's vehicle was struck in the process.
13. On 07/02/24 at 12:08p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shot Spotter at 2812 W. Fond du Lac. Investigation revealed a suspect had been denied service due to a previous incident, and discharged their firearm at the sidewalk. One casing was recovered. The business was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident.
14. On 09/07/24 at 7:22a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Stabbing at 2740 N. 28<sup>th</sup> St. Investigation revealed a subject who suffers from mental health issues, entered 2812 W. Fond du Lac., and when asked to leave, swung a coffee pot at the employee striking them on the head and leg. The coffee pot broke and the subject's hand was cut. The employee stated they are aware of the subject's mental health issues and did not want to prosecute.

15. On 02/19/25, at 10:00p.m., an officer was dispatched to a Trouble with subject complaint. The caller stated the ATM stole his money and an employee was refusing to give them a refund. The caller was no longer on scene upon arrival. A check of merchandise revealed some expired food items, which the employee stated they would take care of immediately.
16. On 03/03/25, at 4:11 p.m., officers were dispatched to a Battery complaint. An unknown subject implied they had a weapon, pushed an employee, and threaten to come back to damage property.
17. On 03/05/25, at 4:03 p.m., officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject. An employee asked a known subject that caused a disturbance in the past to leave, but they refused. The subject was gone prior to officers' arrival.

20. On 07/09/25, at 2:13p.m., officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject complaint. An employee reported a female loitering near the gas pumps refusing to leave, and making threats to cause damage. Security camera footage was requested to be emailed.
21. On 07/10/25, at 12:57 p.m., officers conducted follow up on a reported Robbery. Security camera footage provided by the business showed two suspects and the victim near a gas pump. Suspect one removed the victim's wallet from their rear pocket. The incident was determined to be a theft from person.
22. On 10/10/25, at 7:44 p.m., officers conducted a Traffic Stop in the lot, which led to arrests being made. A canvass of the business followed. A manger on scene stated, the business is open 7-days a week 24 hours. Three employees are always on duty with a total of five employed. There is no security company contracted. There are working security cameras, but only accessible by the owner. No violations observed.
23. On 12/15/25, at 8:18 p.m., officers were dispatched to a Battery complaint. An employee identified the caller as problem person. The caller refused any additional police service, and the battery was found to be baseless.
24. On 01/04/25, at 1:59 p.m., officers were dispatched to a Theft of Firearm. The victim reported they had their gun in hand when a male grabbed it and ran off.

Upon my arrival I observed a M/B standing outside with a white Volkswagen parked at a pump. He approached us and began describing what happened, as the business had called the police on his behalf. I identified the subject verbally as Michael K. WAKEFIELD (M/B 10/15/1997). He stated that he had been verbally arguing with a friend over money, and that he had given his car keys to the store employee for safekeeping, as he was afraid for his own safety. P.O. SOSA spoke to WAKEFIELD's friend, who confirmed that there had been a verbal argument earlier, but that it was over now, and agreed to leave so that WAKEFIELD felt safe.

  - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.


