Purpose of Amendment:

The purpose of this amendment is to amend the City's Vendor Service Contract for Black Male Achievement Advisory Council (BMAAC) Consultant with Pivot Consulting, LLC, by increasing the contract total by \$45,000.00 from \$45,000.00 to \$90,000.00. Additionally, extending the contract term for one (1) year from, 01/01/2026 through 12/31/2026, exercising the one (1) and only option to extend. The funds being added are for the purpose of continuing the work from the previous year.

Background:

Bevin Christie of Pivot Consulting, LLC helped the Common Council President to establish the Emerging Youth Achievement Advisory Council (formerly known as the BMAAC), a dedicated entity addressing the diverse needs of Milwaukee's youth and young adults. Bevin oversees the design, development, and operationalization of this new council. She was selected based on experience. When BMAAC met regularly she was an active participant. She also helped the City's My Brother's Keeper Action Plan achieve certification by the Obama Foundation.
