

Historic Preservation Certificate of Appropriateness Solar Checklist

Background

The City of Milwaukee Historic Preservation Office requires a Certificate of Appropriateness (COA) for solar installations completed in historic districts (addresses with codes 1, 2, 3 or 5). The COA is issued by City staff, in line with Milwaukee's solar zoning ordinance and Wisconsin Statute 66.0401.

The goal of the COA is minimize or eliminate the visual impact of the solar panels from public right of away, when placed in historic structures. If you know the property is in a historic district, please submit the following items when you submit your electrical permit application (in addition to the Solar Permit Worksheets).
