Returned herewith is a document filed by Attorney Laurie Eggert for attorney's fees for representing Police Officers Todd Smolen and James Bryce. The claim is in the amount of \$512.50 including \$6.50 in disbursements for 4.60 hours of service billed at the rate of \$110.00 per hour. We ask that this matter be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation.

We have reviewed this claim and advise that in our opinion, the time spent was reasonable. Legal representation was occasioned by a criminal investigation. No criminal charges were brought against the police officers on whose behalf this claim was filed.

As we have advised you under similar circumstances in the past, the Common Council has discretion to reject this claim or to pay it in whole or in part. Wis. Stat. § 895.35, Bablitch and Bablitch v. Lincoln County, 82 Wis. 2d 574 (1978).

The above-named police officers have retained us to represent them in connection with the above-referenced matter.

Consistent with its policy, the City Attorney's Office has refused to represent them, and as they were performing the duties of their office at the time of the events giving rise to the incident, the claim is hereby made on their behalf for the indicated legal fees. This incident involved resisting/obstructing.

The MPD initiated a criminal investigation in which the officers initially declined to give a statement without counsel. When they requested counsel, IAD compelled the officers to give statements concerning the incident after issuing PI-21s. Later, the MPD decided not to issue criminal charges against the officers. Attached is a copy of the clearance report and an itemization of the time and services rendered.

INVESTIGATIVE NARRATIVE:

This report is being dictated by Detective Michael CARLSON, of the Criminal Investigation Unit/Internal Affairs Division (CIU/IAD), day shift.

Investigation revealed that the complainant states that as she exited her vehicle she was confronted by both Officers BRYCE and SMOLEN. She states that both of them attempted to restrain her by grabbing her and she yelled for her boyfriend. She states at this time that P.O. SMOLEN, after grabbing her in the back of the neck, punched her twice in the stomach.

The witness, Tory MARTIN, alleges that when he came out of his apartment both police officers were standing by the complainant. He states that he yelled at them and that P.O. SMOLEN then walked away from the complainant and came toward him holding a can of mace. He states that Officer SMOLEN threatened him and that he, MARTIN, then backed away. He states that Officer SMOLEN then went back to where Officer BRYCE was. He states that it was at this time that he observed Officer BRYCE strike the complainant once in the stomach.

Another witness, Monique WHITE, stated that she observed the incident from across the unlit street and observed numerous squad cars present. She states that she then saw the complainant standing, handcuffed behind her back, by a car. She states that she then saw a lone police officer standing in front of her and that this officer struck her in the stomach.

The complainant was issued a citation for Resisting and on July 18, 2001 pled not guilty to the citation. She is currently awaiting a pre-trial date on September 5, 2001 for this citation.

All the statements by the witnesses and the complainant contradict each other as to who, what, when, and how the alleged incident occurred. The complainant has no injuries and only alleges pain. Due to these facts the complaint has no prosecutable merit and will be cleared as unfounded.
