1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):

The Milwaukee Police Department is the host agency for the Southeast Wisconsin Threat Analysis Center (STAC), an all crimes, all threats, information sharing fusion center for the eight counties of Southeast Wisconsin including Milwaukee, Waukesha, Racine, Kenosha, Walworth, Ozaukee, Washington, and Dodge. Grant funds will be used to support operational costs, travel/training to maintain required certificate credentials, and equipment replacement/upgrades to maintain and enhance STAC capabilities.

2. Relationship to City-Wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:

The STAC mission is to gather, receive, analyze, and disseminate information and intelligence to law enforcement, fire services, emergency management, public health, military and private sector partners in an expedient manner to effectively protect the region and state. The grant aligns with the goal to reduce crime and enhance quality of life through threat assessment and identification, information/intelligence sharing, and collaboration to prevent terrorism and other catastrophic events.

The total grant award of \$61,000 with a grantor amount of \$61,000 will fund training and travel, equipment, and operating expenses including supplies and technology software. No Department match is required.
