

Bluestone Front Walk and Stoop

1. Front sidewalk: 28 ft. 6 in. long x 4 ft. wide
 - a. Remove existing walkway between city side walk and front stoop. (Leave concrete walk portion between city sidewalk and curb)
 - b. Excavate soil as necessary and install 6-8 in. compacted #1 gravel base.
 - c. Install Bluestone (full range) walk
 - Set on mortar with latex enhanced mortared joints
 - Bluestone portion approximately 4 ft. wide
 - Belden 760 soldier course edge set tightly together on mortared base. Brick joints to be filled with polymer sand.
 - Acid wash
2. Front stoop: 11 ft. 6 in. wide x 7 ft. 4 in. deep
 - a. Cap existing concrete stoop with Bluestone to match sidewalk. Sidewalk course of brick around outer perimeter with mortared joints.
 - b. Face front and sides of stoop with brick and mortared joints. Set on steel angle attached to stoop.
 - c. Latex enhanced mortar joints.
 - d. Acid wash

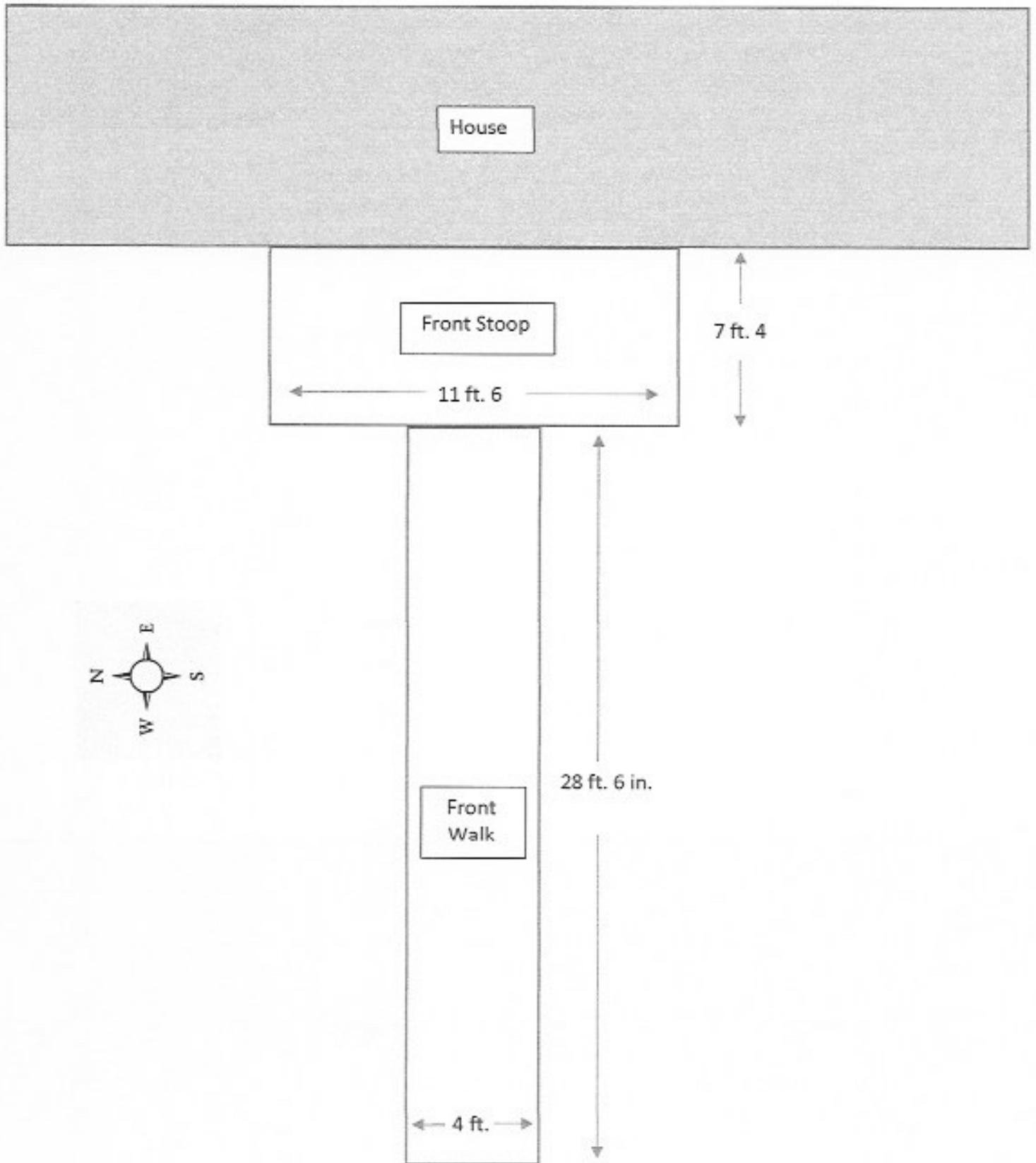
