Your Class A Malt and Food Dealer License Applications as agent for "Midget Food LLC" for "Midget Food" at 2500 N Booth St.

There is a possibility that your application may be denied for or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Limited parking for persons attending meetings in City Hall is available at reduced rates (5 hour limit) at the Milwaukee Center on the southwest corner of East Kilbourn and North Water Street. Parking tickets must be validated in the first floor information booth in City Hall.





The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 2/14/2017 at 10:30 AM, in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.




Our establishment, , has been serving the neighborhood since the 1960's and has maintained a liquor license in good standing since that time. During the years that our store has been in the neighborhood, we have been witness to many changes. One of these is the explosion on liquor stores / taverns in the area. It seems that each year, new liquor licenses are being issued in the neighborhood which is becoming over saturated with them.

In the one mile radius around the proposed new licensee, there are 37 existing licensees. In the 3 mile radius around the proposed new licensee, there are 195 licensees, as listed on the enclosed document. As one can see from the list, licensees are sometimes only next door or across the street from one another.


It is our opinion that the concentration of liquor licenses is too great and further licenses should not be issued in the neighborhood. There are likely areas of the city with lower concentrations of liquor licenses that would be better suited to the addition of a new vendor. With the concentration as high as it is in this neighborhood, after a certain point, each additional license granted creates a negative impact on the overall quality of life of the residents. Therefore, we ask that the license committee not issue the license in question.

Hi Mr. Kovac,

I hope you're doing well. This email is a LONG time coming, and I really hope there's something you can do to help.

My husband and I own a duplex on from Club 99, a bar.

in Riverwest. We live

The bar continuously plays loud music at night, and keeps all its doors open. We can literally hear the bass booming in our home -- windows rattling, etc. We have tenants above us who also hear the same things we do. The bar also has a problem with super loud people standing outside talking, yelling, screaming, throwing bottles around, at all hours of the night. There are also frequently cars parked outside blasting their radios and just being completely obnoxious.

We have a decent relationship with the bar owner, Willy.

we've even had to call the police a couple times. We HATE that we have to do this. We are constantly policing him, and it's just no way to live. We feel that he talks a good talk to us about how he's going to try to keep things quieter, but once his patrons are in the bar, he no longer has a backbone and lets them do whatever they want. He also parties right along with them, so tends to lose control over his patrons. We just can't keep calling him every single night asking him to quiet down. When we do call, he normally shuts the doors, which at least keeps the music from reaching our house. But there are always still people outside, bottles left on our lawns, etc. It's just very disrespectful and not representative of the rest of our neighborhood.

I'm wondering why there's not some kind of neighborhood bar rule in Riverwest. This might be Riverwest, but it's not Water Street. It's residential. I can recall going to bars in residential neighborhoods in Bay View -- and at 10pm everyone needs to be inside, all the doors are closed, etc. There are signs inside and outside the bars asking people to please be quiet and respectful of the neighbors. Why can't we do this?? It just seems ridiculous that there is this loud, bumping, ridiculous bar smack in the middle of a generally quiet neighborhood. We are just sick of being the "bad guys" and harping on the bar owner. We also feel that it puts us in danger when the bar is being loud and we have to go stand on our porch and tell people to quiet down. It's just not a safe situation for anyone. It's also sad that we can never even consider sitting on our porch on the weekends -- it's just too loud and crazy out there.

We love Riverwest and my husband has lived here for 20 years. We aren't asking for silence or even quiet --just respect. We are constantly cleaning up trash, mowing our neighbors' lawns, and going above and beyond to
make at least our little corner a nice place. We would really appreciate your help in figuring out what to do with
Club 99 so that our neighborhood can be pleasant for everyone.

This report is written by Police Officer Gilbert Gwinn, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 10/24/07 at 1:00 am, Milwaukee Police received a tip from a citizen (who wanted to remain anonymous) that there was drug dealing going on inside the tavern Club 99. Investigation revealed a patron that was inside of the tavern was in possession of suspected cocaine. Officers interview this subject who stated he uses the cocaine for personal use and hangs out at the club because his father tends bar there. This suspect also stated that several other patrons in the bar sell cocaine. He was arrested and charged with POCS - Cocaine.
- 2. On 06/02/2009 at 1:15PM, a Milwaukee Police Department squad was sent to 409 E Burleigh St, regarding a battery complaint. The victim stated she was at "Club 99" tavern on 05/31/2009 between 10:00PM and 10:30PM when she got into an argument with a known suspect. The victim then went into the bathroom and upon returning to bar area was struck in the face causing her to fall to the ground. The victim went to St Mary's hospital and received several stitches to her lip. The licensee and his son were cooperative with the police during the investigation and provided a copy of the video footage.

- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

On Wednesday, November 25, 2015, while assigned to Squad 2741, I was assigned to the Wisconsin WINS Youth Tobacco Initiative, which checks area vendors for age compliance tobacco purchases. I was working with Cleveland EASLEY, B/M, 03-27-99, who is 16 years old and not of legal age to purchase tobacco. A photo of EASLEY was taken at the beginning of the assignment for identification.

At about 4:23 pm, EASLEY entered Green Ring II liquor store located at 3305 N. Martin L. King Jr. Dr. and purchased a pack of two Swisher Sweets cigars for \$0.99 cents. EASLEY provided a description of the cashier that sold him the tobacco. I entered the store and identified the cashier as Michael L. HARDISON, B/M, 09-24-59. HARDISON admitted to selling tobacco to EASLEY and apologized. HARDISON stated he did not check his id. HARDISON did not have a valid Class D Operator's License to serve liquor.

The licensee for Green Ring II liquor store was Isaac T. RAGSDALE, B/M, 09-03-71. RAGSDALE was provided the notice to enroll in the Municipal Citation Diversion Program called "MARTS". RAGSDALE was also issued a citation for Responsible Person upon Licensed Premises.

As of January 29, 2016, the agent had not enrolled in the MARTS program, therefore a citation was issued for the violation.

This report is written by PO O'MALIA assigned to District Five Early Power Shift Squad 5252 with PO MILLER.

This report is being submitted for information purposes only. It should be noted that the occupancy license number for this establishment, Green Ring II, which is located at 3305 N Dr Martin Luther King Jr Dr, is 500124 issued on 12-14-03. The Class A license being displayed was number ALQML - 0198781 expired 3-3-15. The licesee stated that his Class A licese was currnet and that he believed he had been displaying the current license. This establishment also had a food dealers license being displayed, number Food - 005988 which expires on 3-3-16. Citations regarding licensing were not issued.

On Saturday 1-9-16 PO MILLER and I responded to a Subject with Gun complaint at 3305 N Martin Luther King Jr Dr. Upon arrival I noted this address belonged to a brick building with the name Green Ring 2 convenience store located on the northwest corner of N Martin Luther King Jr Dr and W Concordia Av.

Upon entering the store I noticed a strong smell of fresh marijuana and several occupants standing around. PO MILLER ordered the group to keep their hands where we could see them while he and PO PAOLO (Squad 5251) patted the subjects down for guns before releasing them from the scene. I spoke to the clerk who was also the business owner and identified himself as Isaac T RAGSDALE (B/M 9-3-71). RAGSDALE stated that he did not call the Police and had not observed anyone in his store with a gun. I then asked RAGSDALE if he had any guns in the store. RAGSDALE stated that he had a pistol in a safe under the counter on a shelf. I then asked RAGSDALE if I could look at it and he told me that the safe was unlocked and just needed to be pulled open. In the safe was a silver over black colored Smith & Wesson SW9V 9mm semiautomatic pistol with a serial number of PBA8213. While on scene PO MILLER observed a holstered black colored Ruger Speed Six Shot revolver on top of a beverage cooler located behind the counter and brought it to my attention. I asked RAGSDALE why he had not told me about this gun when I asked before and he stated that the revolver was his, "Take home gun," and that he had forgotten it was there.

As I was speaking to RAGSDALE PO MILLER observed a abandoned black backpack sitting on the seat of a barber's chair. PO MILLER asked RAGSDALE who the bag belonged to but he stated that he did not know. PO MILLER looked inside of the back pack in search of identifying information linking the abandoned property to the owner and discovered a large plastic ziplock type bag containing a leafy green substance which was later tested by PO MAHNKE (Squad 5467) using a NARK II 05 field test and was found to be positive for THC with a weight of 36.40 grams. It should be noted that PO MAHNKE tested, identified, and inventoried all drugs recovered during this assignment. PO MILLER then noticed a clear plastic sandwich bag full of what later tested positive for THC in plain view located in an open side pocket of the black back pack testing positive for THC with a weight of 10.14 grams. In the small front pocket of the back pack was an orange prescription pill bottle containing 16 Cyclobenzaprine Hydrochloride pills, 5 Tramadol pills, and 1 Acetaminophen/Oxycodone pill. The name on the pill bottle was unreadable. PO MILLER again asked RAGSDALE who the bag belonged to and he stated that it belonged to, Jamie," but that he did not know this subject's last name. RAGSDALE stated that Jamie worked as a barber inside of his store. PO MAHNKE placed the pills on MPD inventory number 16001102 and the marijuana on MPD inventory number 16001101. The pills were identified using the Drugs.com pill identifier.

PO PAOLO located a clear plastic container sealed with a blue plastic lid on top of the partition wall which separated the clerk's counter form the rest of the store. Inside of this container were 15 clear plastic bags containing a green leafy substance. PO MAHNKE also tested this substance using the NARK II 05 field test. The substance tested positive for THC with a total weight of 6.6 grams, and placed it on MPD inventory number 16001101 with the other marijuana.

While this was happening I observed a clear plastic bag sitting on the inside ledge (clerk's side) of the same partition containing an off white chunky substance which I believed to be crack-cocaine. I asked RAGSDALE how the bag had gotten to where it was resting and who it belonged to but he stated that he did not know. Once at District Five Police station this substance was tested by PO MAHNKE using a NARK II 07 field test, was positive for cocaine base with a total weight of 0.34 grams, and was placed on MPD inventory number 16001103.

After these items were located PO MILLER and I decided to check the gun serial numbers with the District Five Console Operator and founf that both guns had been reported stolen. RAGSDALE was taken into custody when these firearms were discovered to have been reported stolen MPD IR# 153020006 (Ruger) and MPD IR# 042783085 (Smith & Wesson). The Smith & Wesson SW9V 9mm semiautomatic pistol with a serial number of PBA8213 was placed on MPD inventory number 16010088 by PO BOYAK (Squad 5467). This revolver was placed on MPD inventory number 16001087 by PO DILLMAN (Squad 5467).

PO MILLER called for a CST Officer and Squad 5221 (PO NEUBURG and PO FUERTE) responded. PO NEUBURG will write a supplemental report regarding his part of this investigation. Squad 5221 conveyed RAGSDALE to District Five Police Station where PO FUERTE assisted in the booking process.

PO MILLER also requested a working dog to respond to our location. Squad 758 (PO SMOKOVICH) responded and will write a supplemental report regarding his part of this investigation. It should be noted that SMOKOVICH's working dog did locate two clear plastic bags of leafy green substance in the front of the store in plain view on the floor, a single plastic bag of leafy green substance behind the partition in the area occupied RAGSDALE, and some loose leafy green substance in the rear room of the store. All of this later tested positive for THC by PO MAHNKE using a NARK II 05 field test and was placed on inventory 16001101.

While on scene I located a black jacket sitting on some empty crates next to a barber's clipper set about three feet from the barber's chair where the back pack was sitting. In the front left zippered breast pocket of the jacket I found a social security card with the name James T MOORE on it with the last four numbers of the social security number listed as 9283. I then checked B of I and found a James T MOORE (B/M 8-26-82) with the last four numbers of his social security number listed as 9382. It should be noted that the first five numbers of both social security numbers were the same. I passed this information along to PO MILLER while at District Five Police Station.

On Thursday, January 14, 2016 squad 5264 (PO Chauncey HARRIS and myself) along with Department of Neighborhood Services (DNS) conducted follow-up regarding possible city code violations at the Green Ring II liquor store, located at 3305 N Martin Luther King Jr Drive.

The licensee Isaac T RAGSDALE was present during this walk-though. A kerosene-operated torpedo style space heater was being used to heat the main store area. RAGSDALE stated the heat was not working inside his store and he was using this space heater as the primary heat source. Additional code violations were observed and DNS informed RAGSDALE of these violations.

Inspector Theresa MORALES issued the following orders to correct for condition observed: emergency orders were issued relative to no heat, gasoline inside building, illegal use of fuel-fired equipment, and blocked egress/exits.

On 1/19/2016 DNS returned for follow-up, and found the code violations were corrected.
