File # 040142 is a resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of the Weinhardt Computerized HIV Intervention Grant.

Background

- 1. This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Health Department (MHD) to apply for, accept and fund the Weinhardt Computerized HIV Intervention Grant project from the Medical College of Wisconsin.
- 2. This is a new grant.

Discussion

- 1. The purpose of the project is to assess the effectiveness of HIV risk reduction counseling delivered by a computer.
- 2. This pilot project will give clients accessing services for sexually transmitted diseases at the MHD Keenan Central Health Clinic the opportunity to interface with a computer program in order to receive risk reduction information. Clients will be compensated for project participation.
- 3. This research study will provide information for evaluation of various risk reduction counseling methods.
- 4. This grant encompasses the period of May 1, 2004 through April 30, 2005.

Fiscal Impact

- 1. The total amount of this grant is \$83,369, entirely from the grantor.
- 2. This grant will fund one existing MHD position within the STD Surveillance and Treatment Program, Nurse Practitioner, SG 670, with salary and fringe benefits.
- 3. Program supplies are budgeted for \$2,000.
