The 2005 Capital Improvement Program includes the improvement of South 6<sup>th</sup> Street from South Chase Avenue to West Maple Street under the Surface Transportation Program. The Federal Program provides cost participation for the improvement of traffic control devices in conjunction with the highway paving.

One hundred percent of the total cost will be funded by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WISDOT).

We have, therefore, prepared the attached resolution, which authorizes and directs the Commissioner of Public Works to execute a Service and Supply (S&S) contract with WISDOT that allows City forces to install and/or modify traffic control facilities in conjunction with the improvement of South 6<sup>th</sup> Street from South Chase Avenue to West Maple Street in the 12<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> Aldermanic Districts.
