This is to notify you that on Tuesday, May 7, 2024, the City's Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council to renew with a 15 (fifteen) day suspension the Extended Hours Establishments license based upon the preponderance of the evidence on the police report, aldermanic and applicant testimony that demonstrates the operation results in a threat to health, safety or welfare of the public for the disturbing after hours incidents involving weapons, fights, lack of a reliable security company and poor management and; to give time to the new security to present results; for the premises located at 3801 S 27th St. ("DENNY'S #8092").

On May 10, 2024, you were mailed a true and correct copy of the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendations of the Licenses Committee with respect to the Extended Hours Establishments license in which the Committee recommended renewal with a 15 (fifteen) day suspension of the Extended Hours Establishments license based upon the preponderance of the evidence on the police report, aldermanic and applicant testimony that demonstrates the operation results in a threat to health, safety or welfare of the public for the disturbing after hours incidents involving weapons, fights, lack of a reliable security company and poor management and; to give time to the new security to present results. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of Tuesday, May 21, 2024 commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of the right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time, and place, you did file written objections to the report of the Licenses Committee, you did not appear in person and you were not represented by a counsel.

Following consideration of the report of the Licenses Committee, the Common Council voted renewal with a 15 (fifteen) day suspension of the Extended Hours Establishments license based upon the preponderance of the evidence on the police report, aldermanic and applicant testimony that demonstrates the operation results in a threat to health, safety or welfare of the public for the disturbing after hours incidents involving weapons, fights, lack of a reliable security company and poor management and; to give time to the new security to present results. The suspension is in effect between 12:01 a.m. on May 21, 2024 until 11:59 p.m. on June 05, 2024.
