On Saturday, July 19, 2014, I was assigned to the Wisconsin WINS Youth Tobacco Initiative, which checks area vendors for age compliance tobacco purchases. I was working with Xavier T. ASHFORD, B/M, 04-07-97, of 618 W. Locust St., phone #262-617-1811, who is 17 years old and not of legal age to purchase tobacco. A photo of ASHFORD was taken at the beginning of the assignment for identification.

At about 12:40 PM, ASHFORD entered Mothers Foods located at 2438 W. Hopkins St. and purchased two Swisher Sweets summer twist cigars for \$1.00. ASHFORD provided a description of the cashier that sold him the tobacco. I entered the store and identified the cashier as Yasir A. GHANI, A/M, 02-01-88. GHANI admitted he sold ASHFORD tobacco and apologized because he was underage. GHANI had a valid Class D Operator's Liquor License.

The licensee for Mothers Foods was Ali M. FARHUD, A/M, 02-25-89. FARHUD was issued a citation for adult sell tobacco to person under 18.

- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Dear Ms. Soliz:

I received your letter of October 28<sup>th</sup>, 2014 in which our breweries request for a loading zone was denied. I realize that there are parking concerns on the street, but I'd like to appeal the denial. On August 25<sup>th</sup>, 2014 there was a neighborhood meeting at our brewery to discuss the planned expansion of the brewery to the lot just to the east of the Holton Street Bridge. During the meeting, the discussion of traffic on the street came up. One request that came from several of the neighbors was to have a loading zone in the front of our brewery to prevent the traffic congestion caused by double parking of cars. I agreed with our neighbors and applied for the loading zone. This loading zone will not only prevent the double parking problem and the safety of those getting in and out of their cars, but should be allowed also for the following reasons.

The loading zone will only take up one parking spot. There are a few hundred spots on the street and the removal of one will not be noticed to the neighbors compared to the benefit they will receive in less congestion and safety.

Do to the nature of our lots topography, the handicap parking spots are located approxamently 150 feet from the buildings front entrance ramp. Due to this, handicapped individuals must travel a far distance to get to our front door. If a loading space was allowed, handicapped individuals can be dropped off in front of our building and reduce this travel distance greatly. I frequently see handicap individuals being dropped off in front of our building out of double parked cars.

The loading zone will give our tour buses and delivery trucks an open convenient spot to park to drop off close to our building. Without this spot they frequently have to park farther down the street which is closer to our neighbors which will cause more traffic and noise for them.

## **ADDITIONAL COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS:**

This supplementary report is written by P.O. Laurel Lammers, assigned to District Five, early shift; as the Community Liaison Officer. On Friday, December 5th, 2014 at 12:00 pm, I met with Saed Nabman regarding Mr. Nabman's application for a new liquor license for 2909 N. Holton St. which will be opened under the name of Freedom Grocery.


The proposed business is located on the east side of North Holton Street just north of East Locust Street. The building is zoned for mixed use, commercial and residential. The commercial part of the building occupies the lower east side of the building. The main entrance door for the proposed business is on the east side of the building facing out towards Holton Street. The building is clearly marked with the address and does have appropriate lighting along the east and north side of the building. On either side of the main entrance door, are two large picture windows that will allow for visibility into the business. The south set of windows are currently boarded up, due to damage. The north set of windows are covered with signage from the previous occupant, not allowing visibility into the store. Currently, there is not a business occupying the building.

Mr. Nabman plans to open the business as Freedom Grocery, and would like to open as soon as possible. He stated that he is currently in the process of remodeling the store. I did observe that the store was basically empty; did have new flooring, and did have some cabinets built in along the south wall of the store that will be shelving for the cash register area of the store. He stated that he plans on enclosing the cashier area with bullet proof glass, and will have a door on both the east end and west end of the enclosed area. The coolers will be installed along the north wall, and then shelving will be installed throughout the remainder of the store to shelve food items. Mr. Nabman plans of selling food, tobacco, and beer items from the store.

I did speak with Mr. Nabman about installing cameras and gave him information regarding the Surveillance Camera Program that is being sponsored by the Milwaukee Police Department and Safe & Sound. He did state that he already purchased some cameras for the interior. I did advise him that it is required to have at least one camera facing the counter and register area, and one facing the entrance. I also advised that he purchase a safe that can be floor mounted. Mr. Nabman stated that he would be willing to participate in the District Five standing complaint program. He did fill out a standing complaint form and I provided him with two commercial "no loitering, no trespassing" signs.

Mr. Nabman also advised during our talk, that he did already operate another convenience store within the City of Milwaukee, and he was familiar with the daily operations of running a store. He also stated that he has already completed the Robbery Prevention Training, and that he completed that class some time last year.




