RICHARD CLARK

was honored during a special ceremony prior to the November 25, 2025 Common Council meeting at City Hall, recognizing his decades of selfless service and leadership in Metcalfe Park, where he has consistently worked to improve the community and support its residents; and

WHEREAS, *Richard Clark, a veteran of the United States armed forces and longtime resident of the Metcalfe Park neighborhood, has demonstrated a steadfast commitment to service both in uniform and through his ongoing community leadership; and*

WHEREAS, *Richard Clark is one of the original members of the Metcalfe Park Community Action Team (MPCATS) and has contributed more than 20 years of active and vital service to the neighborhood, fostering a sense of unity, safety, and civic engagement; and*

WHEREAS, *Richard Clark collaborated with his neighbors on the development of the Metcalfe Park Neighborhood Improvement District (NID), helping to spur positive change in infrastructure, beautification, and overall community safety; and*

WHEREAS, *Richard Clark's dedication to community leadership has cultivated an environment in which residents feel empowered to act for one another's well-being, as demonstrated recently when residents mobilized to provide emergency aid to a motorcyclist struck in the neighborhood, likely saving a life; and*

WHEREAS, *Richard Clark's decades of commitment, leadership, and service exemplify the highest ideals of civic responsibility, and his efforts reflect the City of Milwaukee's appreciation for both military service and grassroots community engagement; now, therefore, be it*

RESOLVED, *That the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee herewith recognizes and commends Richard Clark for his courage, concern, and service, and extends its sincere appreciation on behalf of the community, and wishes for him continued health and happiness; and, be it*
