

To provide additional parking in this high on-street parking demand area, we covered the no parking restriction on the east side of N. Farwell Av., from E. Bradford Av. to E. Webster Pl. with the less restrictive no parking December 1 to March 1 restriction on a trial basis. This trial has been in effect for a substantial time period and we have not received any complaints; therefore, we recommend a permanent change. Also in response to your request on behalf of Mr. Jim Wiechmann, no parking will be installed to provide an area to allow sanitation truck access to the dumpster.


Dear Alderman Henningsen:


Dear Alderman Donovan:


