Consistent with its policy, the City Attorney's Office has refused to represent them, and as they were performing the duties of their office at the time of the events giving rise to the incident, the claim is hereby made on their behalf for the indicated legal fees. This incident involved the pursuit of a suspect during which an officer discharged his weapon and used other force to take the suspect into custody.

The MPD initiated a criminal investigation in which the officers initially declined to give a statement without counsel. When they requested counsel, IAD compelled POs Lacina and Harms to give statements concerning the incident after issuing PI-21s. Later, the MPD did not bring criminal charges against the officers. Attached is a copy of the clearance report and an itemization of the time and services rendered.
