File #061394 is a resolution directing the transfer of funds from the Capital Improvements – Advance Planning Fund to two subaccounts for planning analysis activities and other technical planning studies.

Background and Discussion

- 1. The Advance Planning Fund is used to finance planning studies and research into land use, marketing, development, and redevelopment proposals.
- Currently, to utilize the unencumbered Advance Planning Fund balances, the
 department must obtain authorization to transfer the funds to a sub account via a
 Council resolution. Unencumbered balances are not earmarked for specific projects.
- 3. In 2007, the Advanced Planning Fund was funded at \$175,000 for the following projects. Allocations and expenditures for specific uses are subject to Common Council approval.

Fiscal Impact

Adoption of File 061394 authorizes a \$44,000 transfer and expenditure from the 2007 Advance Planning Fund to fund the following subaccounts:

- \$24,000 into the Planning Studies-Economic Development account
- \$20,000 into the Special Engineering and Technical Studies account

Adopting this file leaves a \$131,000 unencumbered 2007 Advance Planning Fund balance.
