Dear Mr. Klumb:

This office is in receipt of your claim in the amount of \$75.00, relating to damage you sustained to your property on September 8, 2003 when you allege the City of Milwaukee police broke a wall outlet at 2710 South Howell Avenue.

Our investigation reveals that the Milwaukee police conducted a "knock and talk" on the date in question. The police department does not have any records regarding this alleged damage which indicates it was an ordinary "knock and talk". Since you did not present any evidence to support your damage allegation, the City cannot accept liability for your loss. Accordingly, we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a letter within 21 days of the receipt of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Wells Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202, requesting a hearing.
