South 35th Street to South 1st Street and from
West Virginia Street to West Lincoln Avenue

Dear Council Members:

The 2005 Capital Improvements program includes the computerized optimization of traffic control signals in the area bounded by South 35th Street, South 1st Street, West Virginia Street, and West Lincoln Avenue funded under a Congestion Mitigation Air Quality Grant.

Eighty percent of the total cost will be funded by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WISDOT). The local share, \$10,580.00, will be provided through the Division's existing Capital Improvement Program.

We have, therefore, prepared the attached resolution which authorizes and directs the Commissioner of Public Works to execute an agreement with WISDOT that allows City forces to modify or install traffic control signals in conjunction with the computerized optimization of traffic control signals in the area bounded by South 35th Street, South 1st Street, West Virginia Street, and West Lincoln Avenue in the 8th, 12th, 13th, and 14th Aldermanic Districts.
