Notice of event giving rise to Injury

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Veronica Tinnon by her attorney, Ryan Kastelic of Kastelic Law Office, states that the following circumstances give rise to a claim:

The undersigned appears on behalf of Veronica Tinnon with regard to slip and fall injuries suffered on a negligently maintained city sidewalk.

Veronica Tinnon was walking on a city sidewalk on March 17, 2013. While walking over a crumbling unstable sidewalk surface Ms. Tinnon lost her footing and fell.
