Notice of event giving rise to Injury

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Veronica Tinnon by her attorney, Ryan Kastelic of Kastelic Law Office, states that the following circumstances give rise to a claim:

The undersigned appears on behalf of Veronica Tinnon with regard to slip and fall injuries suffered on a negligently maintained city sidewalk.

Veronica Tinnon was walking on a city sidewalk on March 17, 2013. While walking over a crumbling unstable sidewalk surface Ms. Tinnon lost her footing and fell. Ms. Tinnon severely injured her left hand as a result of her fall which was caused as a result of the City's failure to maintain said sidewalk surface.

Veronica Tinnon claims that the City of Milwaukee did not properly maintain the sidewalk at the intersection of East Bradford and North Terrace Avenue.

1. The City of Milwaukee has a duty to the public to properly maintain its public roadways highways thoroughfares and sidewalks. Failure to properly maintain the public sidewalk at issue caused personal injury to Ms. Veronica Tinnon. Ms. Tinnon suffered a sprain and contusion to her left hand as result of the City's failure to act.
2. As a result of the City of Milwaukee's Negligence Ms. Tinnon's injuries have required her to seek medical care and attention. Ms. Tinnon's injuries have also caused substantial pain and suffering.

Ms. Tinnon has suffered losses as a result of the Negligence of the City of Milwaukee, and the City of Milwaukee's failure to maintain the sidewalk at the intersection of East Bradford

and North Terrace. You are given this notice in compliance with State law so as to investigate and protect your interests in anticipation of impending litigation. Should you require any further information regarding this incident in order to fully understand the acts of your officers and the rights of my client, please contact me immediately.

Please be further advised that I maintain an attorney's lien pursuant to Wis. Stat. Sec. 757.36. Please direct all further correspondence and communications to my attention.
