5. DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

The project will include removing the asphalt shingles that cover the original wood exterior of the home. We will restore, repair, or replace siding where necessary. Materials used will be cedar siding or cedar shingles where appropriate. In addition, the project includes removing non-historic metal storm windows, repairing original wooden windows, and installing new wooden storm windows. Windows will be manufactured by Lisbon, Storm, and Screen in Milwaukee. The project may include replacing damaged soffits as well as tuck pointing and waterproofing along the foundation. The final item is the potential replacement of an original coal shute. That space is currently covered by a painted plywood board.

This project is limited to the rear exterior of the home. A similar project was completed in 2020 on the west facing exterior side. We intend to use the same contractor, same materials, same techniques, etc.
